




## Total monthly arrivals and voluntary returns of Syrians in Turkey


## Arrival trends and voluntary returns

During the month of November, the total reported number of arrivals increased by 13% compared to the previous month. The registered number of refugees in camps and outside the camps stood at 536,371, an increase of about 5.9% from October. Of this population, 38% and 62% live in camps and outside camps respectively.

Within the refugee camps, there were more arrivals than returns in the month of November. A resultant net camp population increase of about 1% (5,037 persons) was registered in the refugee camps.

Akkakale and Ceylanpinar in Sanliurfa and Elbeyli in Kilis continue being the biggest camps with each accommodating more than 20,000 refugees. Overall, Sanliurfa with over 60,000 and Gaziantep with over 30,000 refugees continue to be the two provinces that host the biggest camp population in South-East Turkey.

Overall, males are more than females. Refugee children constitute the biggest proportion (53%) of the total camp population.
