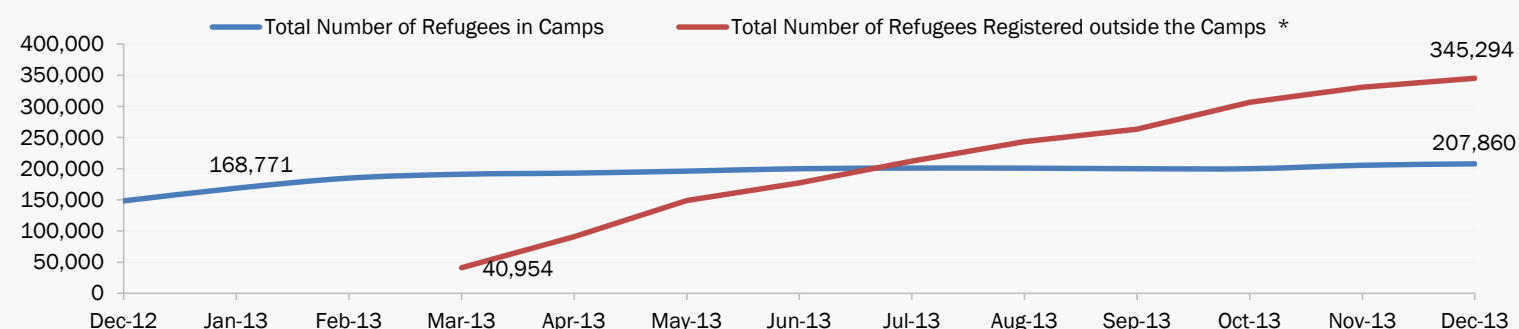

## Highlights

- On 17 December 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps in 10 provinces was 207,860 including 158 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the 48 hours of 15-17 Dec 2013 1,434 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 1,549 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria. All the residents in the Transit Center were transferred to Viransehir and the center will remain closed for a while for renovation.
- Provincial authorities of SASF (Social Assistance and Solidarity Foundation) in Sanliurfa informed UNCHR team that the Governorate started to provide coal to vulnerable families. Reportedly 2,000 Syrian families are planned to be among the beneficiaries. Sanliurfa Governorate SASF Office distributed vouchers to 1,433 Syrian families of which about 807 families already received 500 kg of coal each. The office of Sanliurfa SASF also provided temporary accommodation when needed and already some 5 Syrian families are residing in apartments provided by SASF pending transfer to a camp.
- The population of Viransehir already reached close to 5,000 persons, accommodated in 1,000 tents. Camp officials informed that admission to the camp is subject to prior authorization from AFAD Ankara. Reportedly, the vast majority of the camp's population is from the Transit Center in Kilis, while there were also about 50-60 persons from Viransehir town centers. Some 390 persons of those were previously temporarily accommodated in Akcakale camp.
- In Mardin local officials reported that last week, due to heavy snow, several hundred empty tents collapsed. Also, the school in the camp was closed for 2 days (Thursday/Friday) and the supermarket in the camp for one day on 13 Dec. The camp management distributed about 200 shovels to the camp residents to clean their districts. On the day when the supermarket was closed the management also distributed bread to the beneficiaries. UNHCR had already provided 700 heaters and an additional 600 heaters were delivered to the camp today.
- Provincial officials in Mardin informed that they were intending to transfer some 500 persons living in dire conditions in Kiziltepe. However, this transfer was postponed due to the collapse of tents as mentioned above.
