

## Highlights

- On 22 December 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps in 10 provinces was 208,143 including 108 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the weekend (20-22 Dec 2013), a total of 840 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 914 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria. There is no one in the Kilis transit center.
- According to the official figures reported by AFAD on 22 Dec. 2013, the total number of Syrians registered and accommodated in the camps has increased by 40% since the end of 2012. Reportedly since the beginning of the crisis (April 2011), the number of Syrians registered and accommodated in camps reached to over 428,000 while about 220,000 of them have returned to Syria voluntarily. As the camp databases have not yet been linked, UNHCR cannot verify whether individuals register or return multiple times.
- During the past week, AFAD informed UNHCR that they have deployed two mobile coordination centers, provided by UNHCR, to Hatay for the registration of the non-camp Syrians. AFAD also informed that during the weekend and in the coming days, four more coordination centers will be deployed to Gaziantep, Kilis, Osmaniye and Sanliurfa provinces for the registration of non-camp Syrians.
- According to the official numbers received from the local provincial officials, about 340,000 non-camp Syrians were registered and/or enumerated by local officials in 10 provinces where 21 camps exist. Reportedly 92% of this total are living on 5 provinces namely Gaziantep (33%), Hatay (21%), Sanliurfa (19%), Mardin (11%) and Kilis (8%).
- In Hatay, the foreigners police informed UNHCR that they have enumerated over 70,000 non-camp Syrians of whom about 30% are in Reyhanli, 16% are in Kumlu and 13% are in Antakya city center. In Sanliurfa, AFAD registered about 66,000 non-camp Syrians, of whom 39% are in Sanliurfa city center, 24% are in Akcakale town and 15% are in Ceylanpinar and Viransehir towns. In Mardin, AFAD reported that they have enumerated/registered more than 37,000 non-camp Syrians, of whom 50% are in Kiziltepe town and 23% are in Nusaybin towns, both of which are border towns with Syria.
