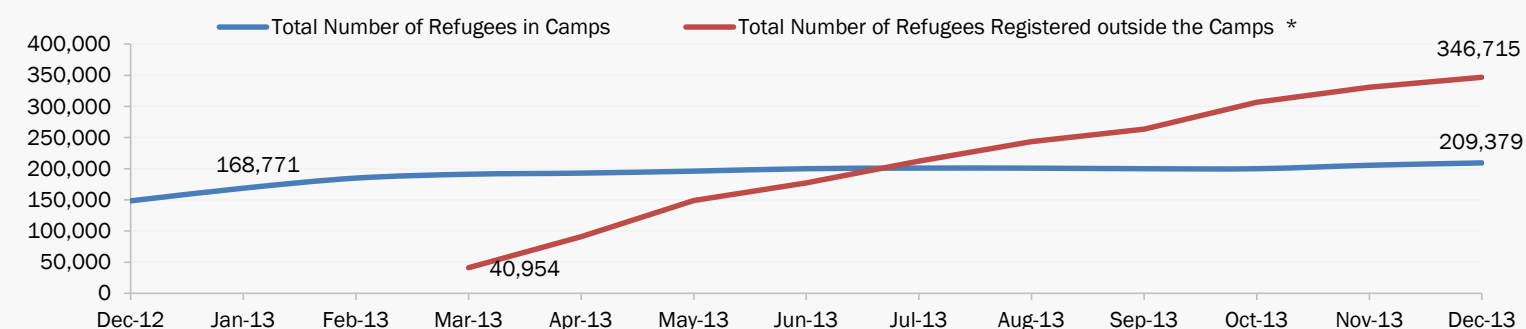

## Highlights

- On 23 December 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps in 10 provinces was 209,379 including 105 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the 24hrs of 22-23 Dec 2013, a total of 1,337 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 101 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria. There is no one in the Kilis transit center.
- After the opening of Viransehir camp on 10 Dec. 2013, the number of Syrians registered and accommodated in the camp reached to almost 6,500 persons. As the camp has capacity to accommodate over 20,000 persons, local officials, informed that new arrivals are admitted only with the referral of AFAD Ankara. In the mean time, officials in other camps with Syrians temporarily accommodated in rub hall tents are also referring these Syrians to Viransehir camp in consultation and with the authorization of AFAD Ankara.
- Local officials in Nizip informed UNHCR that they have confirmed with AFAD Ankara that about 400 Syrians who are accommodated in the waiting area in rub hall tents in Nizip-1 Camp will be transferred to Viransehir camp. Reportedly about 200 of them were transferred on Monday and another 200 will be transferred during the week. Local officials in Akcakale informed that they have referred a few hundreds of those who were accommodated in the waiting area (temporary accommodation in rub halls) as well as some of those who approached directly to Akcakale camp.
- While the camp officials in Viransehir are admitting the people referred by AFAD Ankara, they are also facing challenges with the spontaneous arrivals of about 100-200 persons on a daily basis who approach the camp on their own and claim to be new-arrivals from Syria. Reportedly, regarding one of these groups the camp officials discovered that the people were already registered in Ceylanpinar camp.
- Upon request from the camp management, and in cooperation with AFAD Ankara, UNHCR delivered 250 electrical radiator-type heaters to Adana Saricam camp on Monday, 23 Dec 2013. During the week another 500 heaters will be delivered to Adiyaman camp, and 250 heaters will be sent to Malatya Beydagi camp. UNHCR will continue to provide electric heaters to the camps upon requests from the camp managements.
