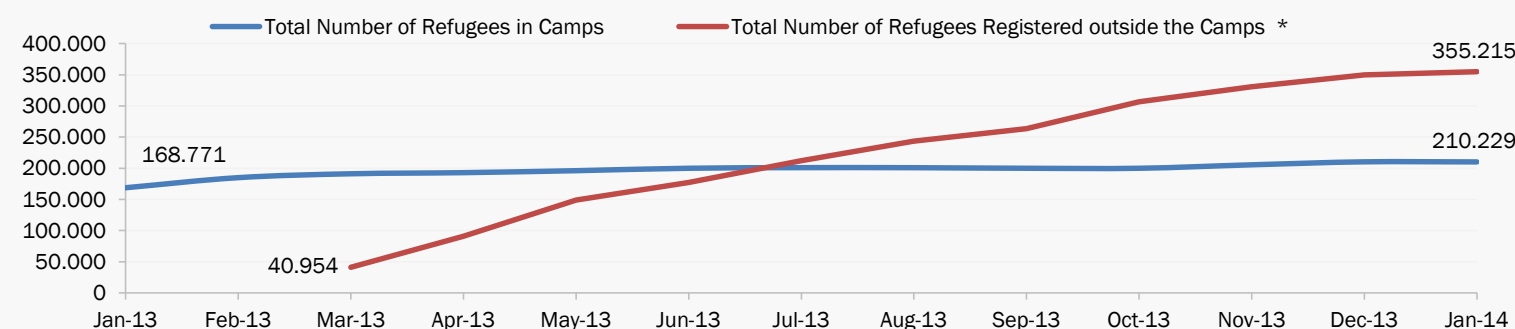

Highlights

- On 06 January 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps located in 10 provinces was 210,229 including 109 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the 24hrs of 05-06 Jan 2014, a total of 153 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 132 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- The UNHCR Public Health Officer visited Viransehir camp and met with health staff working in the camp. The Public Health officer advised the camp manager and the health staff to be attentive to possible malnutrition cases and underlined the importance of raising awareness on breastfeeding. She also suggested to the camp management that in consultation and with the approval of the camp's medical staff, baby formula could be provided as supplementary feeding for the malnourished children.
- UNHCR Teams were informed by the management of Adana Saricam and Nizip -2 that participants of the vocational training course were issued certificates. Reportedly in addition to refugees who did the training on air conditioner maintenance and were issued their certificates, the public education department in Nizip also issued certificates to 12 women who successfully completed the hair dressing course in Nizip container site.
- In Nizip-1 tented camp, the officials informed that they are planning to build additional 10 toilets which will be designed for those who has physical disabilities. Reportedly some portable seats were provided as an interim solution until the new toilets are built. In Adana Saricam camp, upon request from the camp management UNHCR will provide some special seats to be used by the camp residents.
- In Mardin Midyat camp officials informed that they have distributed 100 TL per person through Social Assistance and Solidarity Foundation. Reportedly they received 317,000 TL cash donation from a private donor. Also it was reported that through the private donation the Municipality of Midyat provided food packages to 100 families in Midyat camp, of which 38 families were female headed households and the rest were small size families.
