

Highlights

- On 13 January 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 213,233 including 104 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the period of 12-13 Jan 2014, a total of 494 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 104 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- In Mardin Midyat camp, camp management informed that they have about 22 children of non-camp Syrians living in Midyat who are attending the school in Midyat. It was also reported that during the previous week, the camp management distributed hygiene kits, blankets and pillows.
- In Sanliurfa Ceylanpinar camp, the management is planning to establish 200 additional tents to accommodate about 1,000 or more persons. Reportedly if these additional 200 tents are put in the camp, the camp capacity will be increased up to more than 21,000.
- Officials in Ceylanpinar camp informed UNHCR that after the renovations in the camp recently completed, they have allocated about 70,000 sqm to educational activities including vocational trainings. Reportedly the management is planning to add additional courses like art activities, carpet weaving and a drama course. In addition to these courses, reportedly an author refugee is taking the lead on establishing a library, which she would like to be furnished with additional books in the long term.
- In Kahramanmaraş camp officials stated that they have received about 20,000 TL from the Governorate's office as a donation which will be spent on purchasing fabrics and wool to be used for vocational courses in the camp.
- UNHCR was informed by local officials that they have transferred over 600 Syrians from the waiting area of Viransehir camp to Nusaybin camp. Reportedly the population of Nusaybin camp is increased to 1,891 persons. According to AFAD information note, there are 63 rub halls prepared with 504 sections to accommodate people. Reportedly some 300 of the new arrivals from Tel Abyad were also transferred to Viransehir camp.
