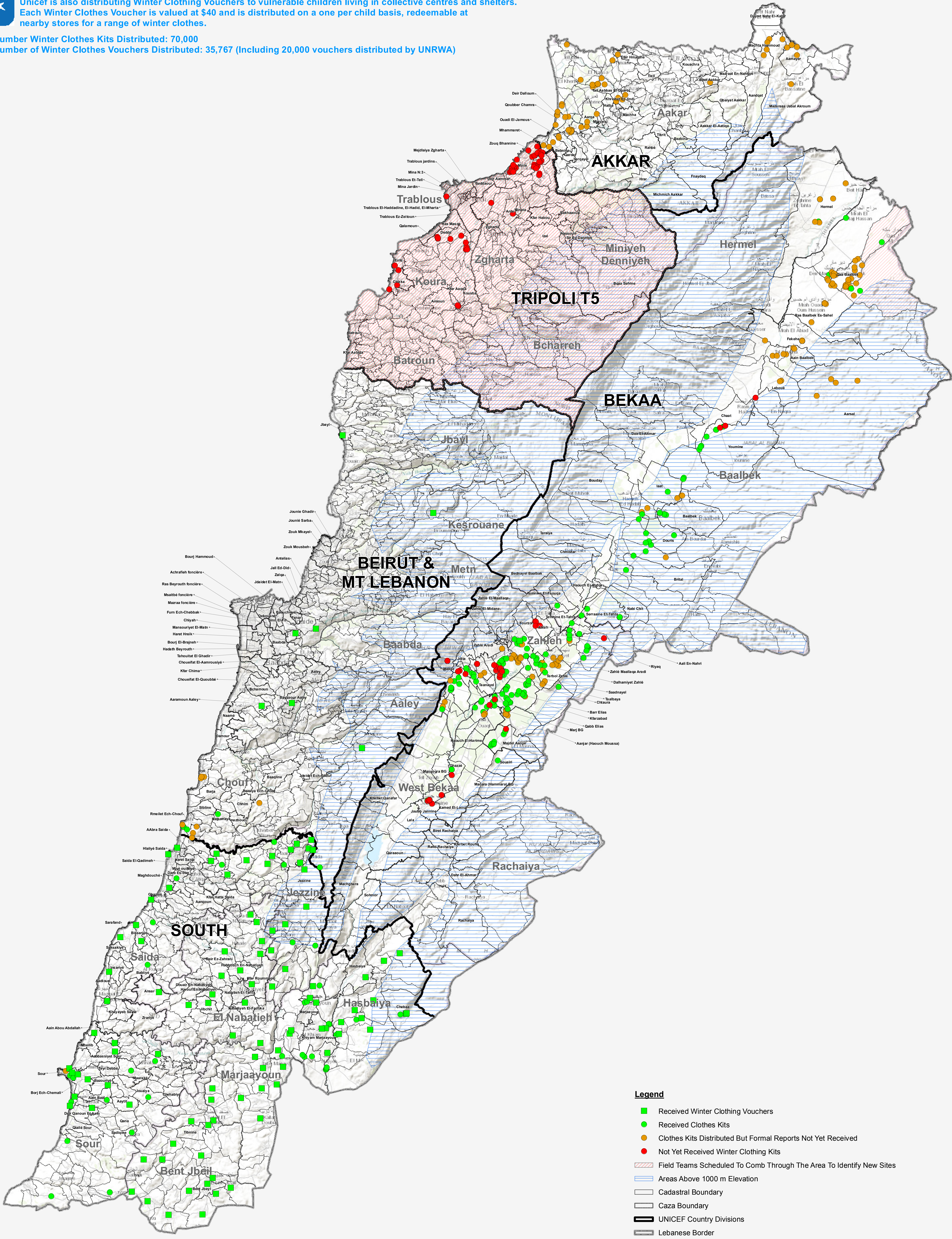
## WINTERIZATION ACTIVITY FOR 2013/2014 WINTER SEASON IN LEBANON

### JANUARY 2014



Winterization is an activity undertaken by Unicef targeting children under 14 living in ITS across Lebanon. Winterization Clothes Kits consist of: a jacket, jumper, pants, shoes, socks, thermals, scarf, warm hat and gloves. Unicef is also distributing Winter Clothing Vouchers to vulnerable children living in collective centres and shelters. Each Winter Clothes Voucher is valued at \$40 and is distributed on a one per child basis, redeemable at nearby stores for a range of winter clothes.

- Total Number Winter Clothes Kits Distributed: 70,000
- Total Number of Winter Clothes Vouchers Distributed: 35,767 (Including 20,000 vouchers distributed by UNRWA)
