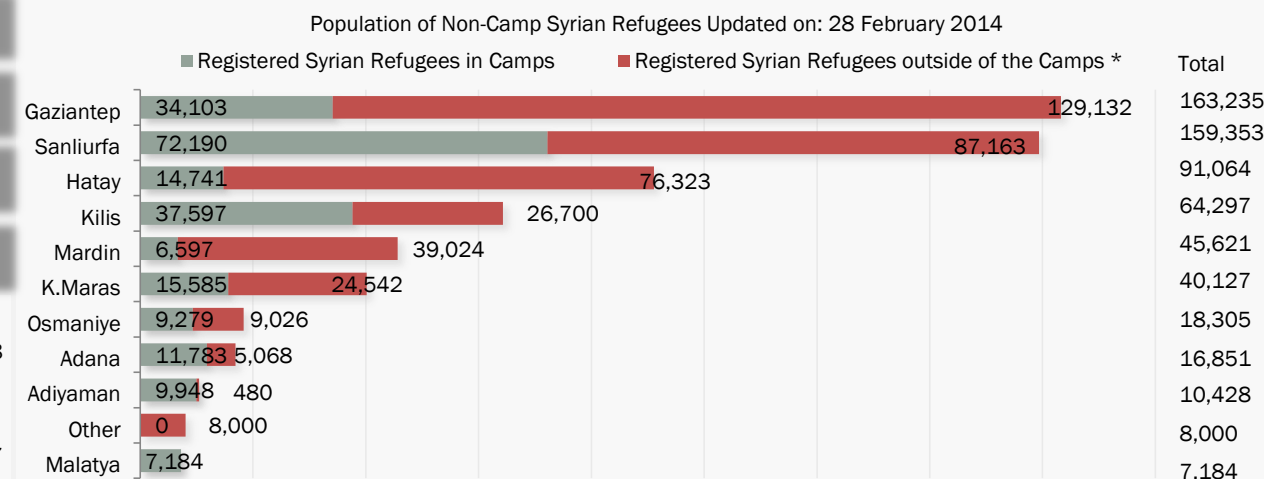
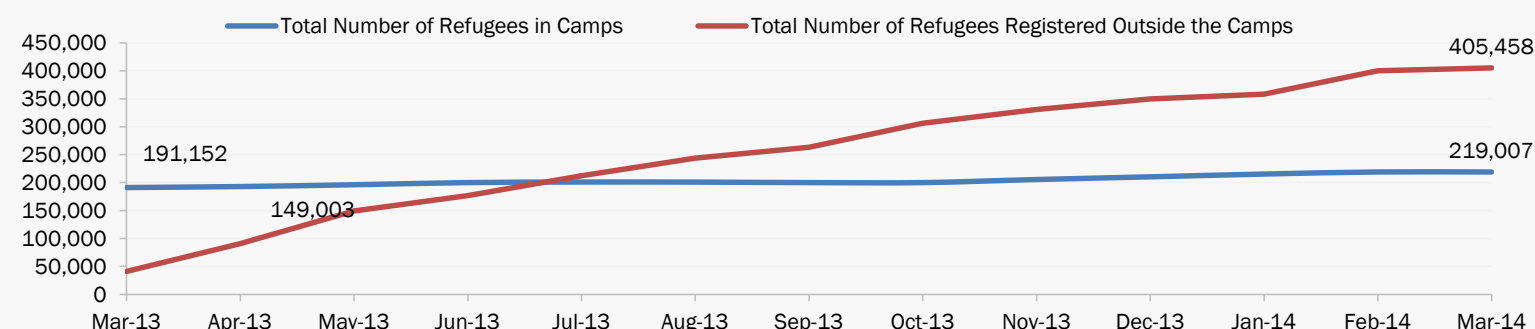

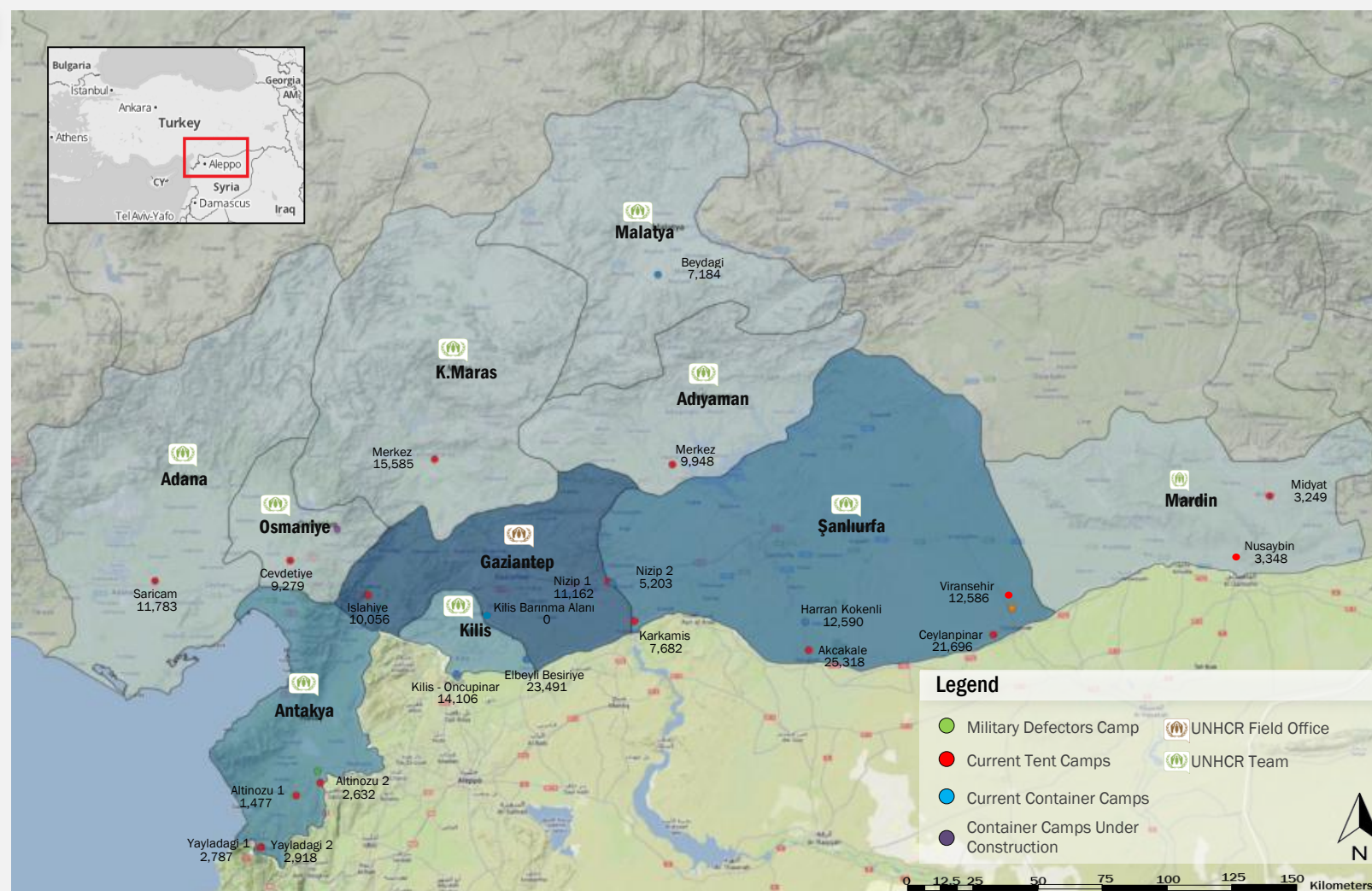

## Highlights

- On 06 March 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 219,007. AFAD reported that during the period of 05-06 March 2014, a total of 130 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 331 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- In Hatay province local officials informed UNHCR that the registration of non-camp Syrians is on-going in many locations. Reportedly in addition to Reyhanli and Kirikhan where the UNHCR donated mobile registration units are used, in Altinozu and Yayladagi towns the registration of those who were enumerated before is almost completed. Should there be new-arrivals, they will also be registered. In Antakya city center, almost 10,000 non-camp Syrians were enumerated in 2013, and their registration has also started. In Altinozu town, officials informed UNHCR that 7,277 non-camp Syrians have been registered while about 5,000 non-camp Syrians were registered in Yayladagi town and villages.
- The transfer of the Syrian refugees who had been temporarily accommodated at the Viransehir camp gate has begun and some 300 of them have been moved to Nusabin camp on 06 March 2014. The others will be transferred during the coming days. Upon request from the camp management, IOM is providing the transportation from Viransehir to Nusaybin. The camp officials in Nusaybin also informed that another 39 Syrians were also sent from Balikesir as per instruction from AFAD Hq.
- In Akcakale, the local officials informed UNHCR that the registration of non-camp Syrians will be done at the camp until the registration/ coordination center premises are completed. According to the local officials the number of spontaneous returns has increased during the last few days (100-150 per day) while the daily average was 50-60 per day before.
- In Gaziantep, provincial AFAD officials informed that one of the UNHCR donated mobile Coordination Units has already been sent to Islahiye town. The UNHCR Field Team observed that the Unit is stationed in/entrance of Islahiye camp and will start to register non-camp Syrians by next week. Reportedly more than 10,000 Syrians have been enumerated by local officials and a local NGO. The second mobile coordination unit in Gaziantep will be sent to Nizip where the local officials already registered/enumerated almost 20,000
