as of 04 March 2014





#### Assistance package:


To all new comers or refugees with pending registration for more than 30 days. 480,000 refugees to be assisted in 2014.

#### Assistance package:

1 medium thermal blanket per person, 1 mattress per person (up to 4 per family), 1 kitchen set and 1 hygiene kit per family, 1 baby kit per child under 2 years, provided to (almost) all newcomers within their first month in Lebanon. Over 500,000 beneficiaries projected in 2014.


#### Assistance package:

1 high thermal blanket per person, 1 stove in kind or \$40 in lieu, plus \$107 per family contribution to fuel costs per month, for 5 winter months (Nov-Mar). Winterization support is provided to one third of registered refugees (targeted at vulnerable families living above 500m in elevation and in all informal settlements regardless of elevation)




#### Assistance package:

In-kind Kit of family hygiene consumables and diapers and cream in the baby kit provided to over two thirds of registered refugees currently (except the DRC caseload in North and Bekaa for which assistance has been monetized at 27\$ per hygiene kit and 13\$ per baby kit).



#### Assistance package:

\$30 per capita per month through E-Cards to purchase food in pre-determined shops selected by WFP. 75% of registered refugees to be assisted every month.
