AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF MSNA

The objective of this inter-agency MSNA is to enable effective prioritization of humanitarian assistance by identifying:

1. Priority needs within and among sectors, and
2. Gaps in assistance with respect to these priority needs.

It also aims to inform the RRP6 mid-term revision

TIME LINE (final)

- ASAP: All data and feedback on info needs received from Sectors
- By March 23: All sector chapters developed (with one day input from Sector Specialists and consultation with all SWGs). **Note this has now been changed to a SWG workshop** (see below).
- By March 28: First draft finalised
- By April 14: First draft reviewed and agreed

WHAT'S NEW THIS WEEK?

Draft chapters developed for WASH, Education, Health, Education, Social Cohesion, Protection (incl CP and GBV), Livelihoods

Sector Specialist inputs received for all above chapters

Agreement to conduct SWG workshops next week to further inform analysis on perceptions of priorities, gaps and risks.

NEXT WEEK'S ACTIVITIES

(March 20 to March 28)

- Send out all sector chapters to SWGs for review (see below time-frame)
- MSNA team to develop cross analysis by geo and target groups, data limitations and recommendations, map info needs against data, harmonise sector chapters, summaries
- SWG workshops to inform perceptions around priority areas, response gaps, risks etc
- Edit of final report
- Submit final draft report to Steering Committee on 28 March

By March 21: Health, Livelihoods, Social Cohesion, Shelter
By March 22: Food security
By March 23: WASH, Basic Needs and Education
By March 24: Protection (incl GBV and CP)
