



PROTECTION

- 195,782** Syrian refugees requested protection in 2014
- 151,018** Syrian refugees registered with UNHCR in 2014
- 1,167** PRS recorded with UNRWA in 2014
- 6,256** individuals provided with individual legal counseling
- 1,043** Syrian refugees submitted for resettlement or HAP



CHILD PROTECTION and SGBV RESPONSE

- 132,859** boys and girls benefitting from psychosocial support
- 2082** boys and girls assisted with specialized services
- 639** service providers trained on SGBV prevention/response
- 9,354** women and girls received dignity kits



BASIC NEEDS / NFI / CRI

- 527,500** persons received unconditional winter cash grants of vouchers to purchase fuel (for one month)
- 50,420** newcomers received unconditional cash grants or vouchers to purchase fuel (for one month)
- 165,950** persons who received Core Relief Items (CRI) (non winter)



SHELTER

- 69,793** persons received cash for shelter
- 46,800** individuals benefitted from weatherproofing of their shelters
- 16,972** individuals benefitted of site improvement in an IS
- 8,869** individuals benefitted from house rehabilitation



WASH

- 43,327** individuals provided with storage containers
- 95,485** persons provided with improved water supply at adequate level of service
- 31,890** persons benefitted from improved sanitation facilities
- 73,493** persons have experienced a hygiene promotion session



PUBLIC HEALTH

- 227,733** primary health care consultations in 2014
- 10,139** pregnant women attended ANC visits in PHC settings
- 11,577** children (<5) vaccinated with routine vaccinations
- 12,989** children (<5) received oral polio vaccine
- 12,732** patients received inpatient care in hospitals



EDUCATION

- 139,098** children enrolled in basic education
- 42,143** boys and girls in non-formal learning opportunities
- 19,756** children benefitting from psychosocial support activities in education settings
- 742** teachers and education personnel trained
- 82** schools were rehabilitated (including WASH facilities)



SOCIAL COHESION AND LIVELIHOODS

- 1,273,000** persons in communities benefitting from CSP
- 103** Community Support Projects (CSPs) completed
- 147** communities benefitting from CSPs
- 7,037** persons receiving vocational and life-skills support
- 1,954** persons benefitting from income generation,



FOOD SECURITY AND AGRICULTURE

- 56** million USD equivalent of e-cards, vouchers or food distributed and redeemed in 2014
- 76%** of planned population benefitted from food assistance
- 81%** of assisted individuals with acceptable food consumption score (>35.5)
- 135,300** animals vaccinated against transboundary diseases
