

RENEWAL OF THE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE FOR SYRIANS ("UN paper")

What should I do to renew my UN paper?

Ask for a renewal appointment **one month** before your UN paper expires. You will find the expiry date of your UN paper on the right side. See picture below:



How do I ask for a renewal appointment?

- ✓ If you registered in the North, South, or Beirut/Mt. Lebanon approach the registration center in your area from Monday-Friday, 8am-2pm.
- If you registered in the Bekaa, call 08800513 from Monday-Friday, 8am-4pm.

What should I do on the day of my appointment?

- ✓ Come with all your family members registered with you. Those who do not come will be inactivated with UNHCR. Thus, they will not appear on your UN paper and will not receive assistance.
- Remember to bring: Important documents, i.e. your passports, family booklet, ID, etc. Documents to support changes in your family, i.e. birth/marriage/death certificate, etc. New phone number if you have changed it.

What happens if I don't renew my UN Paper?

- ✓ You/your family cannot access UNHCR and Implementing Partner's assistance and services.
- ✓ You/your family will be inactivated with UNHCR if your certificate has been expired for more than three months.



The renewal of your UN Paper is free of charge, as any other UNHCR services.
