1) Updates from Field WGs and Task Forces

Emirati Jordanian Camp (EJC):

- First case conference co-chaired by TdH and UNHCR
- IMC to be granted access to the camp by UAE RC for psychiatric services

Azraq:

- Update on ITS eviction and relocation to Azraq camp by authorities
- First Referral coordination meeting took place with UNHCR, UNICEF, IMC, IRC and CARE
- The current population of Azraq is approximately 11,500.
- The Field Protection working group continues to meet all together in Azraq, every Wednesday at 10.30 – 11.30 in Base Camp (UNHCR protection office).

Zaatari:

- Referral coordination meeting took place with protection partners only and then will be opened to other partners +
- safety audit task force met
- SOPs roll-out by district on-going

Task forces:

- UASC TF/ Reviewing forms and SOP / Finalizing expected by end of the month / discussion about ICRC role = add-on on a paragraph for ICRC involvement
- BID: UNHCR will conduct one week training session for FPD and UNHCR case manager on BID; Same training will be proposed to partners afterwards
- NCFA: UNHCR and UNICEF are to sign an agreement with the Minister of social affairs for the family council
- MHPSS: updating of psychosocial standards
