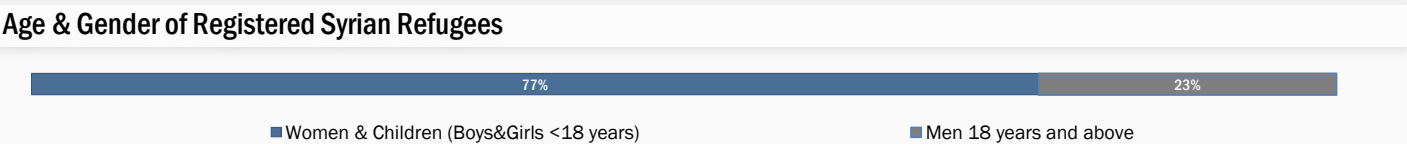
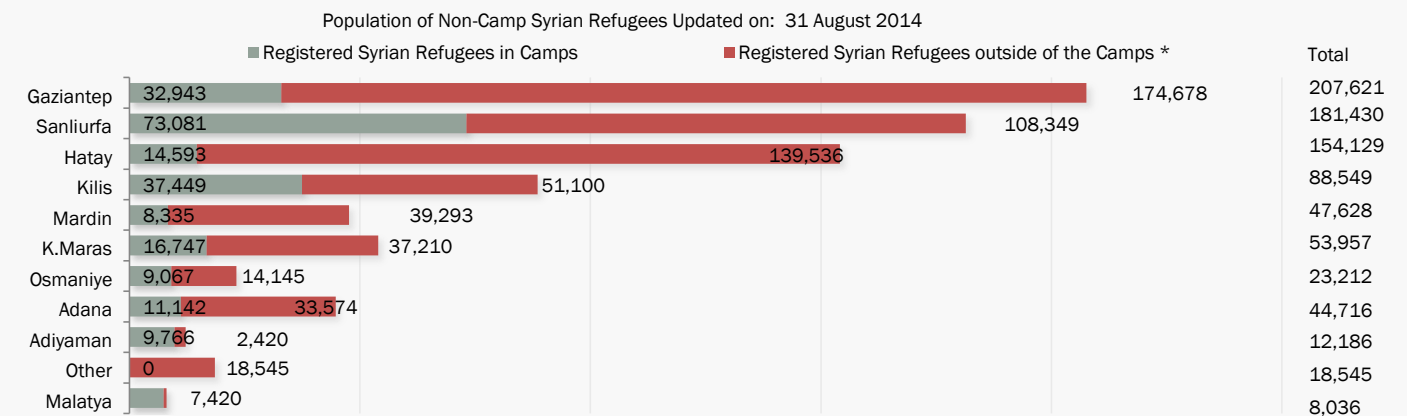
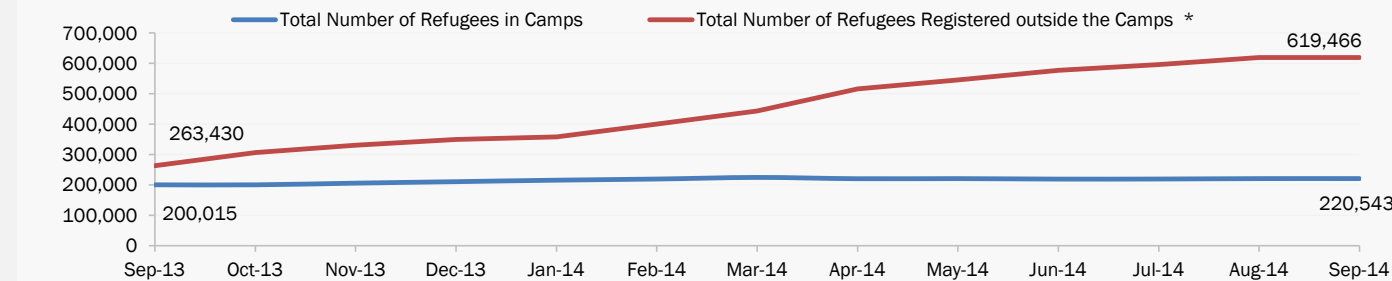

Highlights

- On 03 September, AFAD, the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Turkey's Government, announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in the 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 220,543. AFAD reported that from 02 to 03 September, a total of 518 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 680 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- In Mardin, the registration of non-camp Syrians is on-going only in the coordination center in Mardin city center as there are no registrations taking place in the surrounding towns due to lack of technical capacity. Before the police started to register AFAD had enumerated about 40,000 non-camp Syrians living in Mardin province, mainly in Kiziltepe, Nusaybin and Midyat. As of end of August 2014, about 35% of the total enumerated by AFAD have been registered with police.
- In Mardin, police informed that while they continue to register the Syrians, they are also facilitating the spontaneous returns of those who approach the gate (Senyurt) in Kiziltepe. Reportedly since 2012, the spontaneous return/crossing to Syria of around 131,000 persons has been facilitated through Senyurt crossing point. Around 51% of these crossings took place during Jan-Aug 2014. Officials cannot verify how many of these returns are multiple, stating that there may be thousands of Syrians who crossed back and forth multiple times.
- In Atinozu town of Hatay province, officials informed UNHCR that they have registered 10,154 non-camp Syrians (about 2,200 families). Reportedly the Syrians are mostly scattered in 3 districts of town. During a meeting with some of the local mukhtars UNHCR learned that there is no tension between the local community and Syrians. One of the schools in town is reportedly expected to have about 600 students while last year it had about 350. The school was provided school furniture (desks and chairs) by Turkish national NGO (IHH).
- The shower containers for the section for unaccompanied minors have arrived in Adana Saricam camp and will be installed immediately. The showers will be installed with solar panels for hot water. There are still 7 UAMs (2 girls and 5 boys) accommodated in the section of UAM children.
