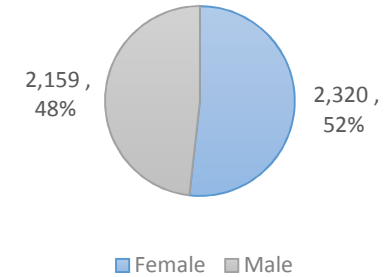
Structured PSS - Age

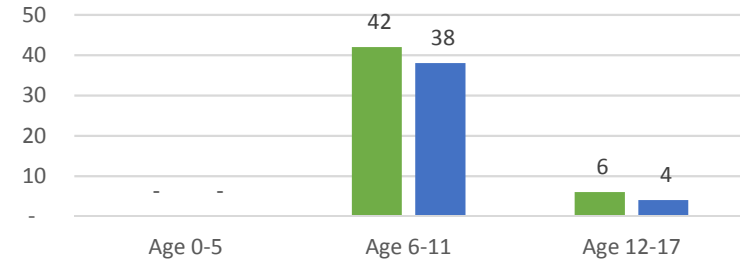

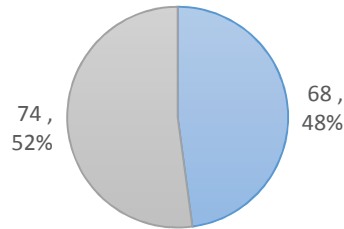

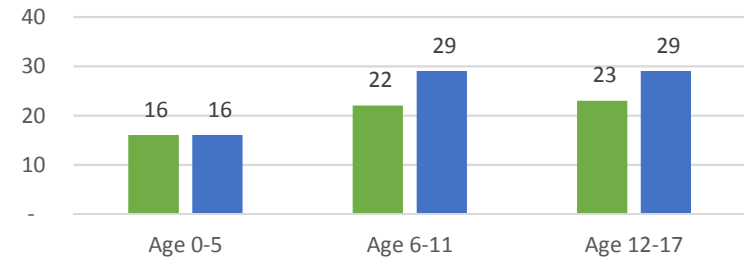

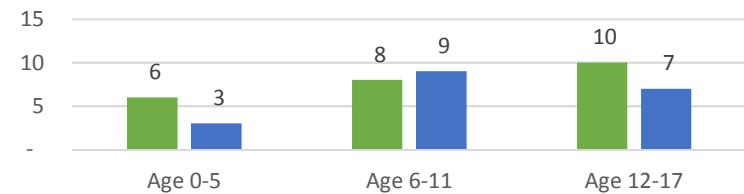
