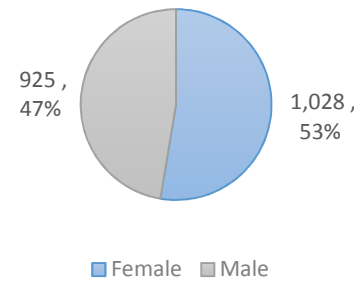
**Cohorts - children sensitized**



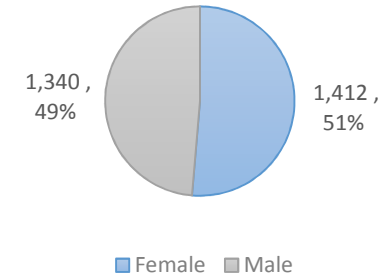

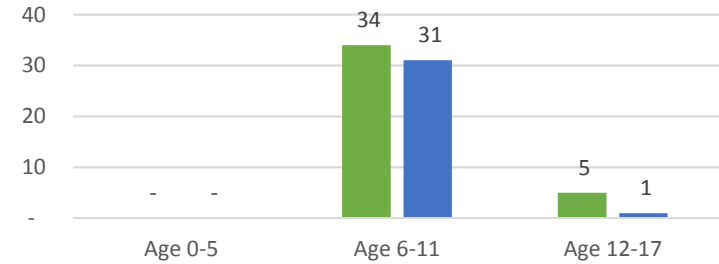

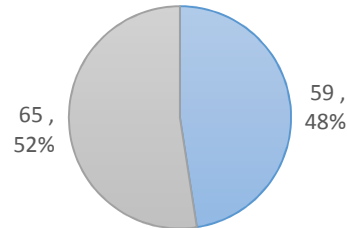

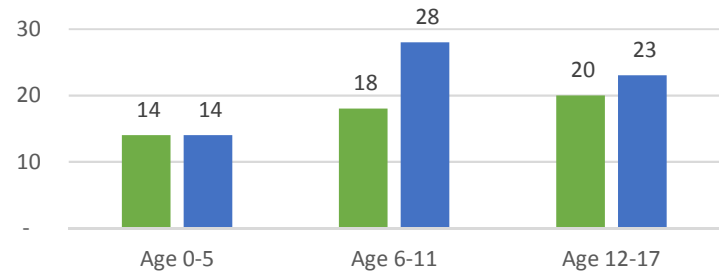

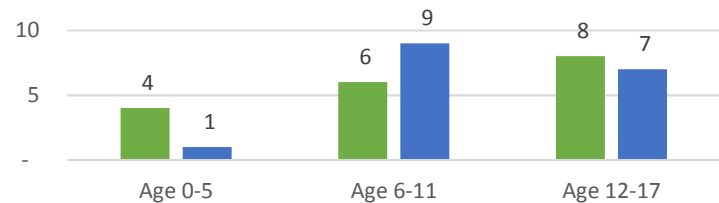
