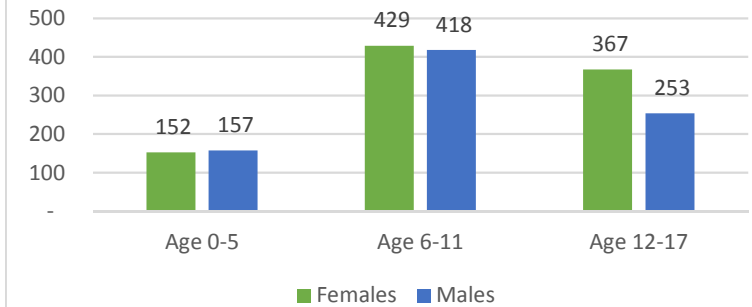
Cohorts - children sensitized



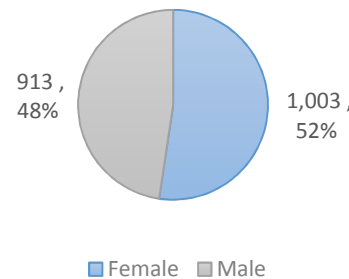
Cohorts - Structured PSS



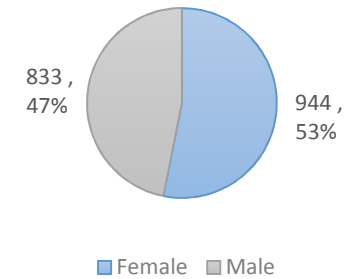
Structured PSS - Age

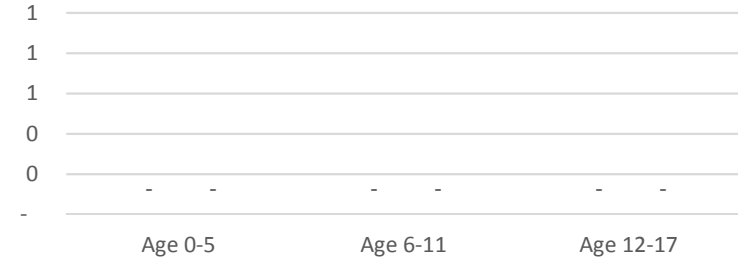

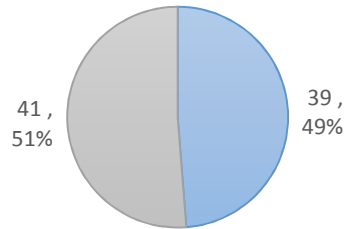

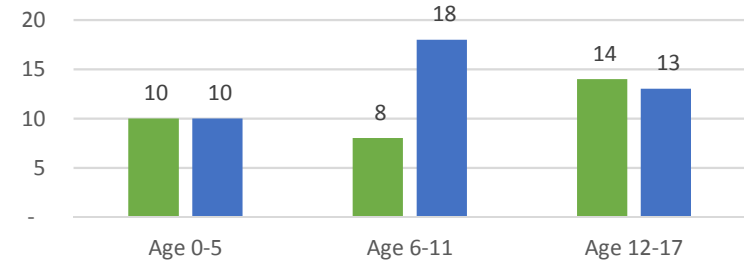

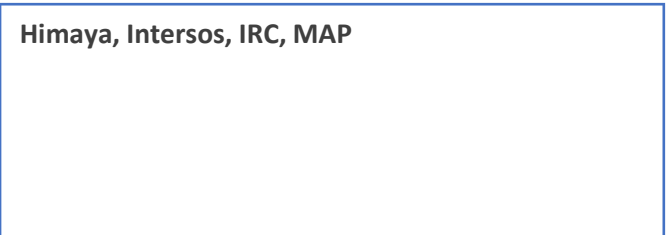
Case Management - Sex
