
HIGHLIGHTS

By the end of February 2016, more than 182,364 households countrywide received winter cash or voucher assistance. An additional 70,000 households received in kind items such as clothing kits, stoves and blankets. Most agencies have concluded winter plans by the end of February 2016 and started post distribution monitoring exercises. An interagency lessons learned workshop is planned in April to assess the efficiency and effectiveness of the plan.




CASH & VOUCHER ASSISTANCE

* Targets represent shelter and economic vulnerable households. Achievements from April 2015 through Jan 2016.




WINTER CASH PACKAGES / CRITERIA

1 SYR 2 LEB 3 PAL

Vulnerable families living above 500 m	\$147 x 4 months
Vulnerable families living below 500 m	\$100 x 4 months
One-off cash for winter top-up (clothing)	\$40/child
Vulnerable families receiving fuel cards in lieu of cash (mainly in Aarsal)	\$100 x 4 months
Lebanese returnee families living above 800 meters and/or with substandard shelter	\$100 x 4 months
