2.	Diddeh and Minnieh municipalities update (re pilot on MRR)
<p>The first meeting on the municipalities' pilot took place and various partners contributed to analyze the MRR undertaken in Diddeh and Minnieh municipalities. The analysis consisted in matching the MRR outcomes with projects that various organizations implement or intend to implement in the respective municipalities.</p> <p>Once the matching is completed, it is expected that MOSA, UNHCR, UNDP and various organizations meet with the Majors and the municipal authorities to present the contributions that each organization provide to the given municipality. UNDP started to compile the matching and <u>attached is the initial result of the initial compilation.</u></p> <p>Action: Partners who have not yet contributed to this document are encouraged to do so by <u>Wednesday 25th March 2015</u>. Please consult lama.srou@undp-lebprojects.org for further guidance. Meanwhile, UNHCR will organize meeting with Mayors. The confirmed dates will be communicated to all partners who in turn will confirm their participation.</p> <p>Future plans Based on the pilot outcomes, the IA group intends to continue the exercise in other municipalities. To this end, MRR outcomes are required for all the targeted municipalities. UNDP is working on this with MOSA at Beirut level.</p>	
3.	Collective Site Management and Coordination Working Group (CSMC) presentation

<p>The Collective Site Management Coordination is a working group operational in T5 and includes contributions for NRC, DRC, UNHCR and Solidarites. All four partners currently manage committees within Collective Sites in various geographical locations.</p> <p>Efforts are made to link the committees with municipal structures so as to gradually build the sustainability of the committees. Refugees living in collective sites are active part of the development of assistance throughout all the project cycle and their capacities are gradually enhanced to ensure that a more consistent self-management is applied throughout the areas.</p> <p>The working group ensures coordination of these activities and has recently developed the CSMC strategy as well as the operational guidance. <u>These documents are attached for easy reference</u> and reflect the content of the presentation delivered during the IA meeting.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Contact details for the committees can be shared with partners so as to ensure that they liaise with committees before conducting assessments, activities or visits in the various Collective Sites. CSMC training will take place in April and will provide capacity building to refugees, municipalities and service providers. <p>Meanwhile, the Protection Working Group is working on a community mobilization strategy which looks into community engagement and empowerment in various locations aside the collective sites. This strategy establishes linkages with the CSMC strategy and aims to ensure consistency among various refugees committees established in different locations and municipalities.</p>	

4.	Survey on social stability working groups
<p>UNDP briefed the forum on the social stability working group and the possibility of creating it in T5. In order to be inclusive of partners' views, UNDP is creating a survey that will be soon circulated so as to seek partners' views on the social stability working group.</p> <p>Action: UNDP to circulate the survey.</p>	
5.	Updates
<p>CARE- Donors have approved an additional year for CARE to provide household level WASH support, targeting Minnieh Dinnieh, Koura and Tripoli communities – programme is expected to run until March 2016.</p> <p>While discussing the agenda for the next IA meeting, ICRC offered to deliver a brief presentation on reconstructive surgery treatment and services for wounded.</p>
