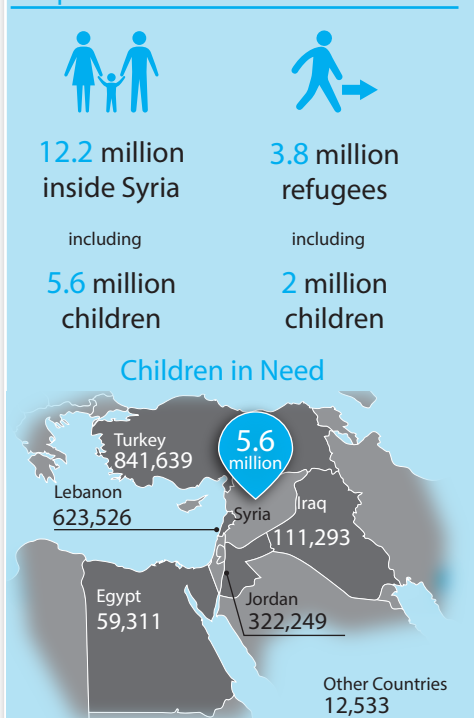


With the conflict in Syria now entering its fifth year, the situation of more than 5.6 million children inside the country remains desperate. There are up to 2 million children who are living in areas of the country largely cut off from humanitarian assistance due to fighting or other factors. Some 2 million children in Syria are still out of school.

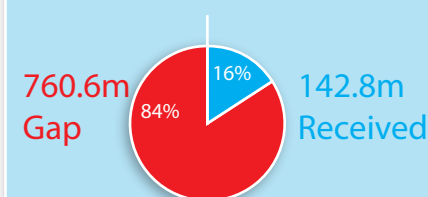
UNICEF is calling for: i) An end to the conflict; ii) More support to learning; iii) More protection for those at risk; iv) Stop the direct involvement of children in the conflict; v) Move investment in adolescents and youth; and vi) Increased support to host communities.

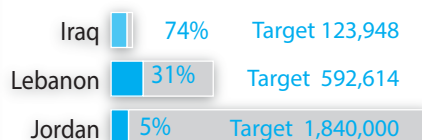


2015 UNICEF Results

Water

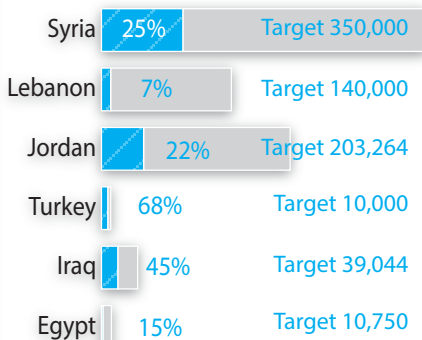
In Syria, UNICEF is providing water treatment supplies that treat enough water to serve over **16.55 million** people on a regular bases.

In neighboring countries, **378,276** people have been provided with access to drinking and domestic water.



Child Protection

There are over **750,000** children targeted for psychosocial support services in 2015, to date **169,105** children have benefited from these services.

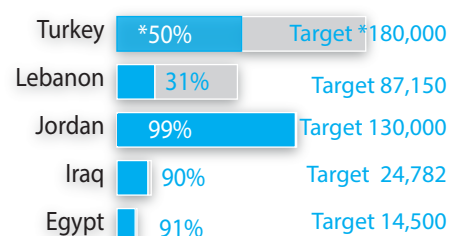

Education

In Syria, UNICEF supported access to formal education for **5,212** students through school rehabilitation, pre-fabricated classrooms and school bursaries.

In neighbouring countries, ***282,014** refugee children have been supported to enroll in formal education .



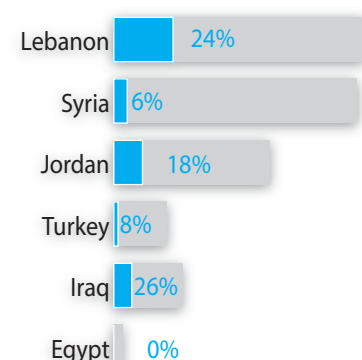

Health

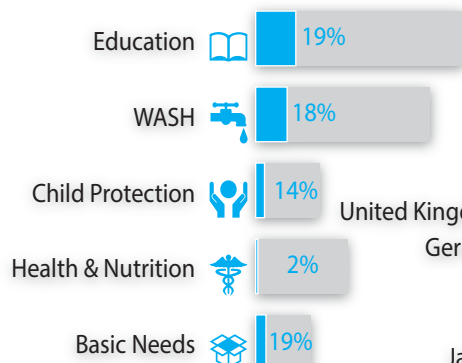
2,994,253 children vaccinated against polio in 1 campaign as of February 2015

There are over **17** million children targeted with polio vaccination in refugee hosting countries 2015, mainly through campaigns. To date **4,594** have been between Jordan and Iraq.
