Jordan Response Plan (JRP) and 3 RP	Both the JRP and 3 RP preparation is in its final stages. Projects uploaded in the Activity info have been finalized. All agencies were requested to review their projects once again to ensure accuracy.
Host Community Minimum Standards	<p>The meeting was informed that the WASH Task Force for the Host Community Minimum Standards has finalized its deliberations except the WASH in Schools component. The meeting also discussed the minimum standards for WASH in Schools and it was agreed that the specific Task Force for WASH in Schools will finalize the minimum standards and share it with the Education sector and then onward with the Ministry of Education for endorsement.</p> <p>The draft WASH minimum standards for Host community (at the Household level and at the Communal level) will be shared by Jamal. All agencies are encouraged to review and give their feedback/inputs.</p>
AOB	UNHCR was requested for latest updates on the Interim Waste Water Management in Zaatari. UNHCR also agreed to present the outcome (relevant to WASH) regarding the VAF for harmonisation of the VAF questionnaire with the Host Community Standards and vice versa.
