US \$ 5.5 million




Total balance as of April 2016
US \$ 18.9 million




Lebanon HF - 2016 1st Allocations

- 24 NGOs were granted funds from OCHA in 2016 to implement 27 projects amounting to \$11 M;
- The projects are targeting over 124,000 vulnerable Lebanese, as well as Syrian and Palestine refugees-- 58 per cent of whom are women and girls.

Lessons learned from the previous allocation

| Issues | Action taken by HFU |

| Sectors to be targeted | Identify a group of sectors and therefore decide on the time and date of the SRCs from now |
| Engagement of the GoL coordinators | Involved in the prioritization/consultation process |
| CA exercise conducted in parallel with the GA process | Potential applicants will be assessed prior the closure of the application on 17 August |
| Technical review | An induction session will be conducted to all applicants on the 10th of August |

Lebanon HF - 2016 2nd Standard Allocation

Following the LCRP 2016 mid-year review, in close coordination with the LCRP coordination bodies and after consultation with **the Inter-sector coordination and OCHA coordination colleagues**, the Humanitarian Coordinator (HC) decided to launch a second allocation for 2016 which consists of the following two windows:

Window 1: calls for integrated programmes targeting vulnerable urban areas and covering identified gaps across three sectors, namely Energy and Water, Shelter, and Social Stability; and

Window 2: calls for innovative projects covering critical gaps identified across four sectors, namely Energy and Water, Protection (GBV/ Disability and Elderly), Health and Social stability.across the following sectors: Energy and Water, Protection (GBV/ Disability and Elderly), Health and Social stability.

Timeline

- **3 - 17 August: The allocation will be open on GMS**
- **10 August: Induction session to all applicants**
- **22 - 23 August: The Sector Review Committees (SRCs) review**
- **24- 25 August: Advisory Board consultation and HC endorsement**
- **Starting 26 August: OCHA technical review**
