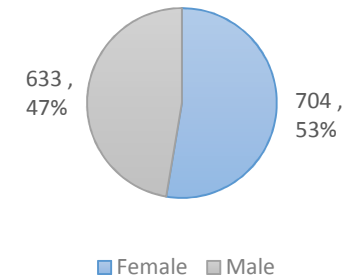

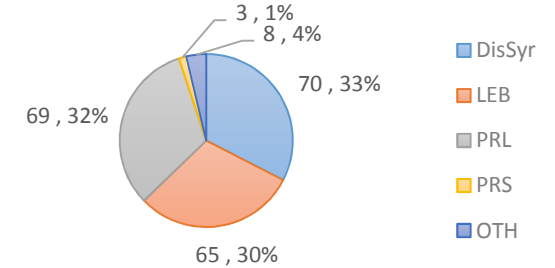
Focused PSS - Cohorts



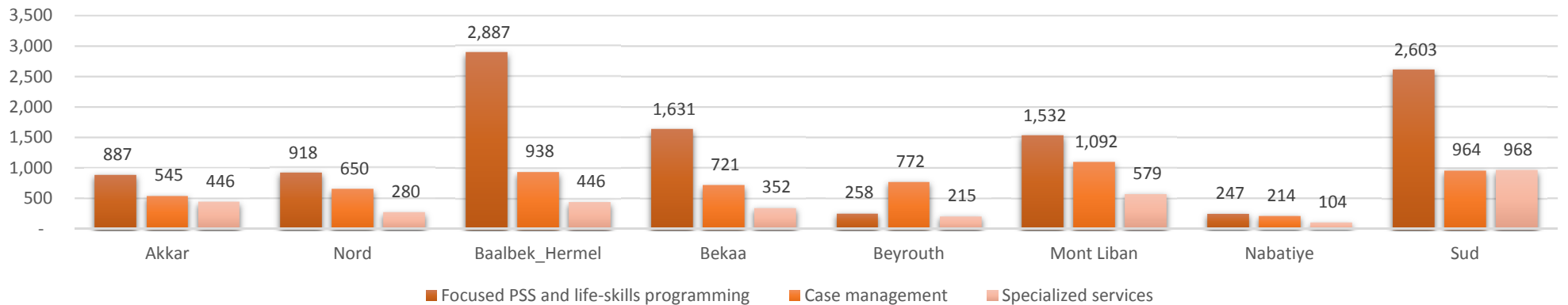

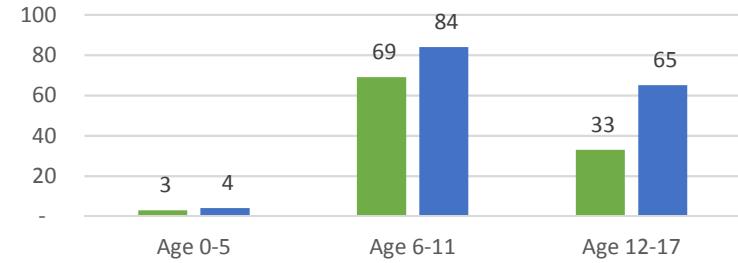

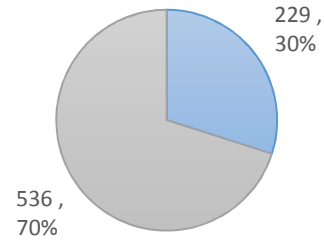

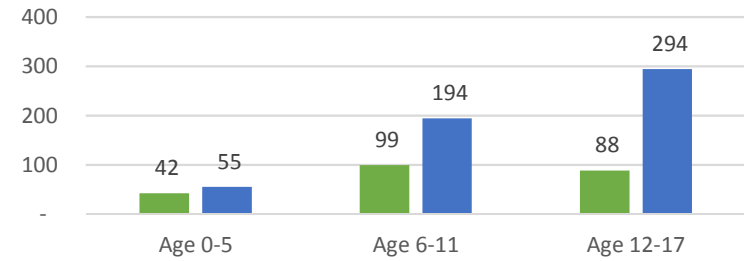
