Update on JRP/3RP related to community health – goals and indicators	Caroline explained about the JRP/3RP process/Activity Info and we went together through the indicators that are related to Community Health. All agencies that were present and supposed to report were reporting in Activity info and are aware about the 2017 submission.

Agency update	IOCC – identification of children with hearing and visual disabilities in Amman, Irbid, Balqa UNFPA – no update, but RH SWG + male task force are tomorrow, starting 930am SNCDD South North Centre for dialogue and development - preventing and treating problem		

behaviours among Syrian refugee children (0-17). Zaatari only. Three stages: 1. Assessing children in and out of school; mapping teachers to know the indicators of bad behaviour resulting from trauma. Masia MOH – 20 trainings and workshops (JICA, UNFPA) on child growth and development (Amman, Balqa, Irbid, Jerash, Madaba).

JICA – by early-mid of 2017 they will have the mobile clinic ready to go. Started peer counselling with disabled Syrians; trained PWD to be peer counsellors (10 days prelim, then two further advanced trainings). Focused in Amman. Prepping for international day for disabled persons (Dec one week celebrating PWD). Doing sporting activities with Syrian PW (in Sports City, table tennis, weight lifting). Disability Task Force meeting – some of the peer counsellors did a presentation; maybe will do another one.

IRD urban – New PRM funding focusing on health / working with MOH. Working in Amman, Zarqa, Irbid, salt, Ramtha, mafraq, jerash, ajloun, madaba, karak, maan. Referring refugees to 38 MOH centers in those areas. Do capacity building for MOH staff in those clinics. Starting in November they will start training 85 volunteers. Fund 19 clinics with new medical equipment. Also referring to INGOs. Focused on PHC. Also doing home visits.

IRD urban (2) - Also for non-Syrian (Iraqi, Sudanese, Somali) refugees. Maternal, newborn, CU5, NCDs, MH, disabilities. Do home visits by 33 CHVs (mainly in Amman and Zarqa). Conduct home visits to increase health awareness and refer them to INGOs.

STC – nutrition survey is complete last week. Azraq, Zaatari, and some urban areas. Shared the primary results with the MOH and will share final report by end of October. Working with Jordan breast cancer for their October campaign to promote breast feeding/detect breast cancer. STC Jordan did breast feeding conference in Jordan on Oct 2, highlighting need for IYCF/raise awareness. Try to have partner private hospitals for counselling sessions.

JHAS – in October they did an NCD training for all new staff. Refresher on internal and external referrals for NCDs. Prepping for smoking cessation campaign next month.

Caritas – started Sept/October awareness campaign about breast feeding/cancer. How to deal with pregnancy and newborn (through the Caritas clinics). Mafraq and Amman. Nov + Dec will do osteoporosis campaign.

El Hadaf (?) – Work with Iraqi refugees and orphans, training in life skills and trauma therapy programs, more than 30 volunteers, medical campaign last year/this year doing a 2 day medical campaign for Iraqis (120 refugees involved). Also doing program for students to get involved with orphan kids, to better understand what extremism did to them? Training refugees in life skills and English courses. In Amman. NGO started 5 years ago, started 3 years ago with Iraqis, orphans, students. Will do Christmas campaign (most Iraqis are Christians), including vouchers for clothes, food, etc.

IFRC – JRC has been doing CH project, amman, jerash, ajlun, ___ balqa. Since sept they have been doing training for CHVs (first aid, BCC, violence prevention, GBV). Will go through end of November. Also submitted a proposal to IFRC for HIV/AIDS in Jordan (hard to get data). Goal is to raise awareness on HIV AIDS. For World AIDS day they want to do an even with partners. Also training project officers and CHV leaders in a TOT.

USAID/HSD – works with MOH and NGOs for CH. RMNCH projects. Raising awareness in communities. Will work with JFPP, IRC. Also designing community engagement model (community health committees, champions, working with schools). Designing ‘secret shopper’ score cards. Asking for any orgs who have experience with this. Ramtha, Irbid, Mafraq, Amman, Karak, Zarqa.

IRC - CHV program ongoing. Received JRC first aid training. HDS did a thorough RH baseline survey in the fixed and mobile clinics

Medair – Expanded the CH program (will be finishing in end of Oct) still continuing with smaller number of CHVs (from 69 to 39 until new funding to come in; expected soon). Mafraq, Zarqa and East Amman. Started PSS program in Zarqa and Amman (sessions for men and women, talk about trauma, identity, grief, loss, hope, etc). Cash for health program (referrals from UNHCR to fully spend money). ID someone who needs health care and link them with MOH. Piloted program where pregnant women receive ATM cards. For other cases, they decide where the service will be provided (MOH clinic), and then schedule the service there. Medair will mostly not pay for care that is not provided by MOH, only incase services is not available in MoH or a beneficiary doesn't have the right documents to access MoH.

IMC (update by email) – working in Azraq camp, CHVs are focusing on Hep A outbreak response (prevention and identification of suspected communicable disease cases). Coordinate with CARE to distribute baby hygiene kits to Village 5 and 2. Distribution was done on Sept 5. Was community
