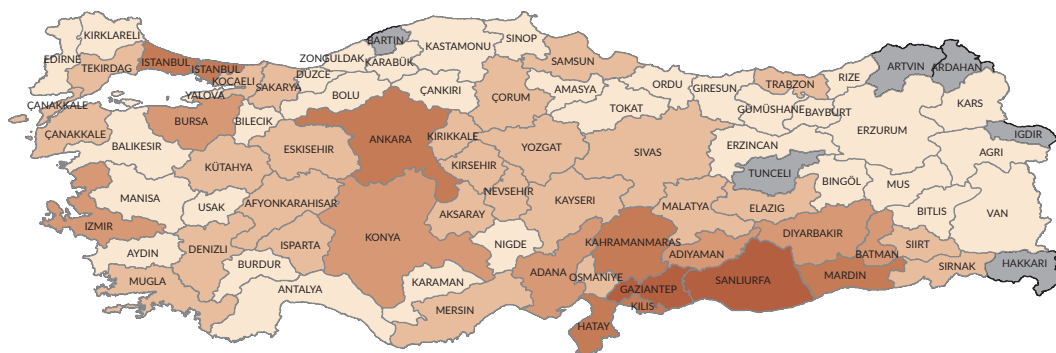
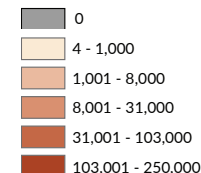




## COUNTRY COVERAGE
