




Top 10 nationalities of Mediterranean sea arrivals in Q1 2017








Overall EU first instance decisions (2016)


■ Geneva Convention status ■ Subsidiary protection status ■ Humanitarian status ■ Rejected


Resettlement arrivals in the EU+ countries (2016)
