



HIGHLIGHTS

In the first quarter of 2017, 13 Basic Needs actors reached nearly 800,000 beneficiaries in southeast Turkey*. More specifically, 392,483 people across the southeast received monthly cash-based assistance, while 152,641 people received one-time cash assistance to enable them to purchase the necessities to endure the cold winter months. A further 173,083 households received core relief items in kind. Through the Basic Needs Working Group (BNWG), partners are now looking to exchange experience acquired and lessons learned through their respective winterization programmes to inform a strengthened 2017/18 campaign.

While 35,000 people in camps were provided with assistance to access adequate shelter in January and February alone, 2,840 people outside of camps have received shelter assistance, and Basic Needs actors recognize the urgent need to step up delivery of shelter and WASH assistance to refugees living outside camps. Indeed, shelter is considered a priority need among refugees in southeastern Turkey, with reports of many families occupying shared and/or substandard property due to a lack of resources and scarcity of available and appropriate shelter (particularly in smaller districts and rural areas). To inform advocacy and programming, multi-agency efforts are now underway to gather further information on refugees' household types and conditions.

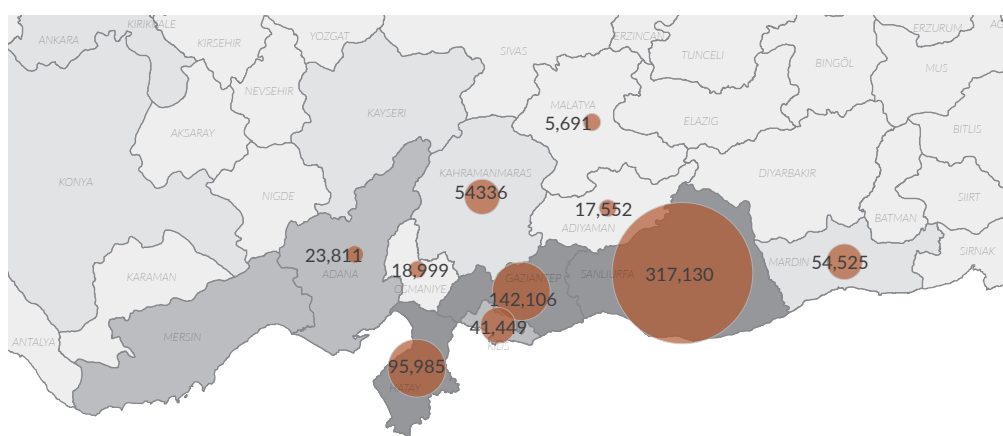

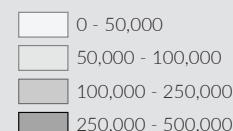

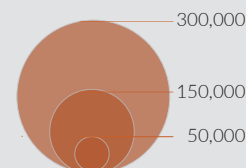
REFUGEES ASSISTED BY PROVINCE

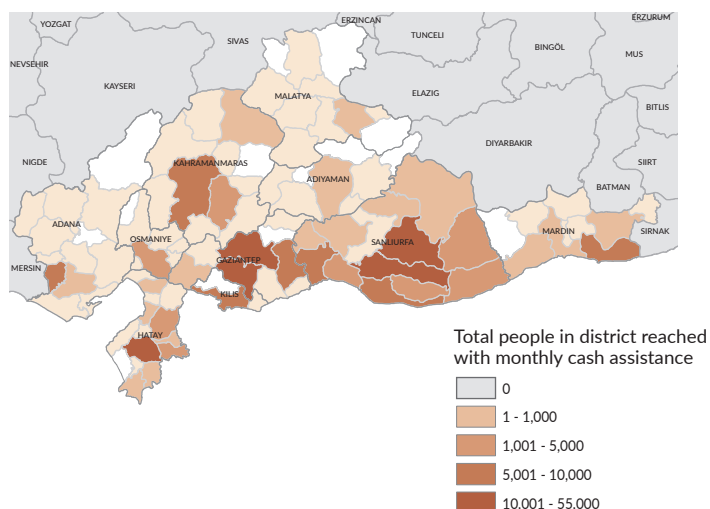

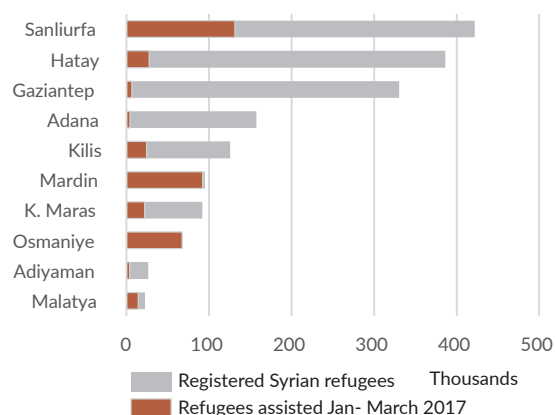

Total people reached with monthly cash by district

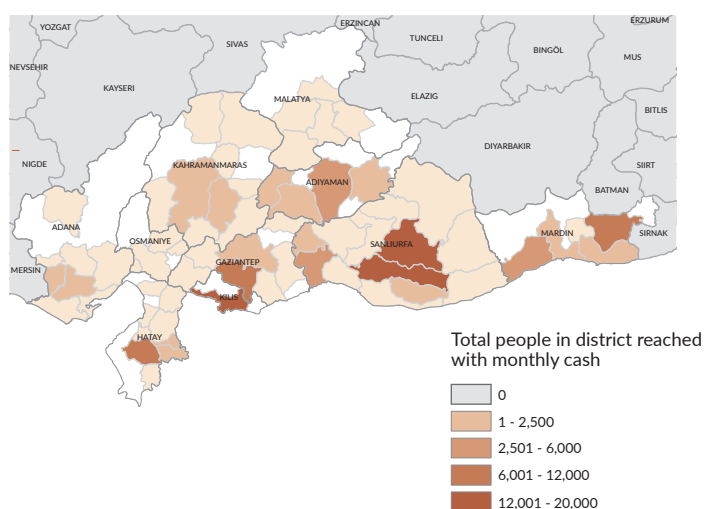


Total people reached with monthly cash by province

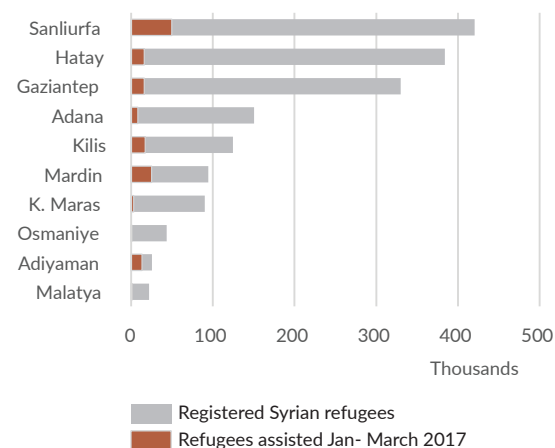


152,641 people reached with one-time cash-based interventions

Total people reached with one-time cash assistance by district

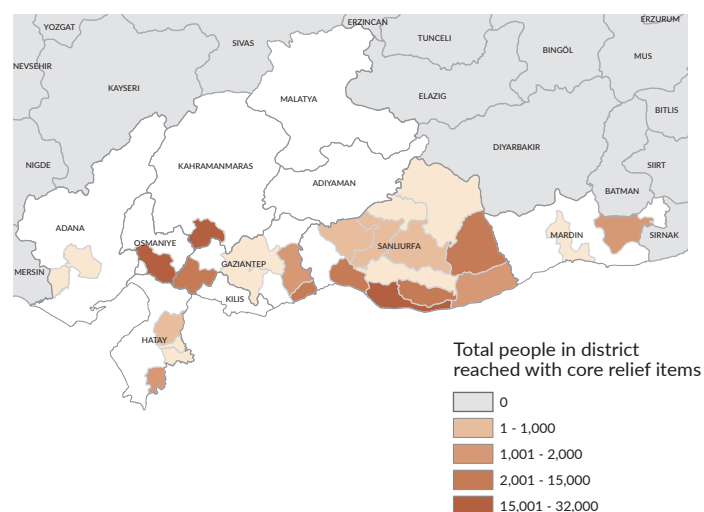


Total people reached with one-time cash by province
