### **1. GEHA Training**

Presenting the proposed agenda, to accommodate the needed knowledge for the new and old gender focal points.

- Support priority to the sectors closer to finalizing their reports

- Sector Gender Focal Points for Protection/SGBV, Health and Shelter the project reviewing process in which they have involved.
- For the next call for proposals, it is recommended to clarify with OCHA in advance to see if the existing Gender Marker will be used or if a new Gender and Age Marker will be used.
