The dashboard for each sector is divided into three sections: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) <b>Priority indicators and sector general info:</b> This section shows the achievements against their respective targets for each of the key indicators chosen by the Food Security sector.</li> <li>2) <b>Beneficiaries reached with Mapping and filtering:</b> the visualised data is extracted from activityinfo; partners who miss the reporting deadline will not see their input in the dashboard.
