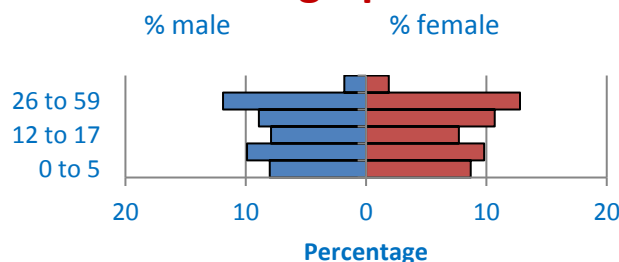

CMC reported 20 displaced households, who live in suburbs, are stealing iron sheets and wood from modular houses.

No cross-cutting issues to report.

### Priorities of the Camp Community\*

- 1) Food rations are late and inadequate, esp. in Sector 4 where IDPs are not on WFP list, but only govt ration list.
- 2) Clinics cannot provide enough types of medicine and cannot support all the IDPs.
- 3) Add'l latrines/bathrooms needed, particularly for women.

### Priorities of Camp Management Agency\*\*

- 1) CMCs obstruction in contractor's process
- 2) Food rations (late and inadequate)
- 3) Shelter renovations for HHs still displaced from cyclone
