



During the reported period, Private Sector Partnership with Malaika; an export company for refined handicraft products, have been developed and is underway to operationalization. The company is going to utilize refugee artisans. Focus group discussions, testing exercises of work and field visits to their main production factory were conducted and further steps have been taken to start including Refugee Women in the different lines of production.


Continued mapping and profiling of employment agencies has been conducted during May that yielded an initial mapping structure and a selection criteria for the wage employment track.

Technical livelihood mission was conducted to Alexandria and meetings were held with Alexandria business association who had been supported is partnering with Caritas Refugee livelihood program. Field monitoring visits were also conducted to different Supported Syrian business and lessons/observations were discussed among the team and with the partners.




**113,000** Syrian Refugees  
expected by end-2017




**378,407** Refugees & Local

by end of 2017




**3RP 2017 Funding Status**
