<sup>2</sup>Actual capacity is calculated as the subtraction of current places minus 14% which is this week's estimated average natural loss for mainland and 9% for islands. Natural loss is the number of places that cannot currently be used because of damages/repairs, protection issues, family size, etc. The formula applies to all type of accommodation.

Actual capacity is a close estimate of available places to be used as reference.

<sup>3</sup>Occupancy rate is calculated as the percentage of current population over actual capacity.

\*Based on a full headcount as of 13.11.2017, the actual available capacity was estimated to be lower at 1,152. This can be used for immediate planning.
