<sup>2</sup>Actual capacity is calculated as the subtraction of current places minus 19% which is this week's estimated average natural loss for mainland and 3% for islands. Natural loss is the number of places that cannot currently be used because of damages/repairs, protection issues, family size, etc. The formula applies to all type of accommodation. Actual capacity is a close estimate of available places to be used as reference.

<sup>3</sup>Occupancy rate is calculated as the percentage of current population over actual capacity.

\*The actual available capacity is estimated to be at 728. This derives from 148 places on islands and 580 places on mainland. It can be used for immediate planning.

<sup>4</sup>The additional 244 places provided by UNHCR in hotels in the islands have been set up as an interim winterization solution.
