

IRAQ - Camps Intentions Survey Round 2: Camps in Erbil, Dahuk, Sulaymaniyah and Diyala, January 2018



This Intentions Survey was carried out by REACH in partnership with the CCCM Cluster in 28 camps across Erbil, Dahuk, Sulaymaniyah and Diyala governorates hosting a total of 40,114 households (211,259 individuals). The survey was administered to 2,609 households, corresponding to 19,404 individuals through a random sample¹ between 12 December 2017 and 14 January 2018.






Are you currently planning on returning to your

area of origin (AoO)? By governorate of origin


What is the condition of your house in your area of origin?




Planning to return to area of origin



If yes, what are the main reasons for why you would like to return to your area of origin?²

















If it were possible, what are the main needs you or your family require to return in a safe and dignified manner to your area of origin?²
