How to make Fire-Fuel Briquettes step-by-step



Get 20 litres of water. Gather waste materials such as paper, grass, agricultural waste and/or animal dung.



Mix waste materials with water into thick paste.



Stir mixture once every 10 minutes.



Step 5



Dry briquettes for 2 days, or until completely dry. Avoid using wet briquettes as this produces lots of smoke.



Some materials (e.g. crop residues) may need to be soaked in water for 1-2 days before being compressed to briquettes. This poster shows the different steps involved in the production of Fire-Fuel Briquettes which can be used to cook on fuel-efficient cookstoves.
