BASIC INFORMATION

POPULATION FIGURES

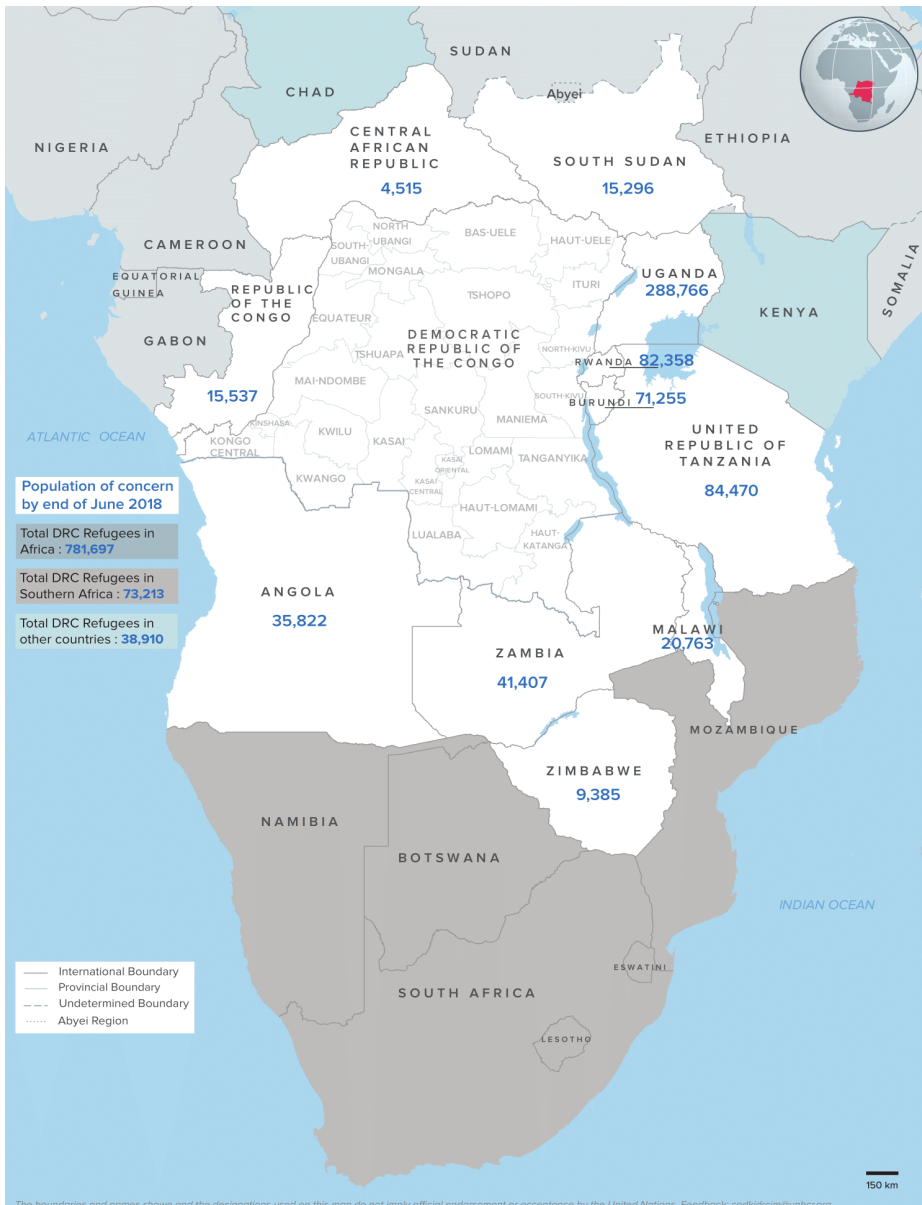
- The figures in this report have been updated to reflect the results of a **continuous biometric registration and verification exercise** in countries of asylum.
- The total figures include additions (new arrivals and births) and subtractions (departures, deaths, no-shows during food distributions and deactivations).

EMERGENCY LEVELS

- On 20 April 2018, the **highest emergency level (L3)**, which was declared by the UN on 20 October 2017 for six months for some parts of DRC, including the Kasai region, South Kivu and Tanganyika provinces, was deactivated.
- The L1 which was activated on 10 September 2017 for Zambia and the L2 on 16 February for Uganda, are ongoing.
- The L2 which was activated on 23 May 2017 for Angola and the L1 on 10 September 2017 for the Republic of Congo, are under review.

FUNDING

- UNHCR received **\$35.2 million** for the DRC situation, representing **only 10 per cent** of the total requirements for 2018, which amount to \$368.7 million.
- The interagency Regional Refugee Response Plan (RRRP) for the DRC situation has received **\$41.6 million**, as at 12 June 2018, representing only **8 per cent** of the total requirements for 2018.
