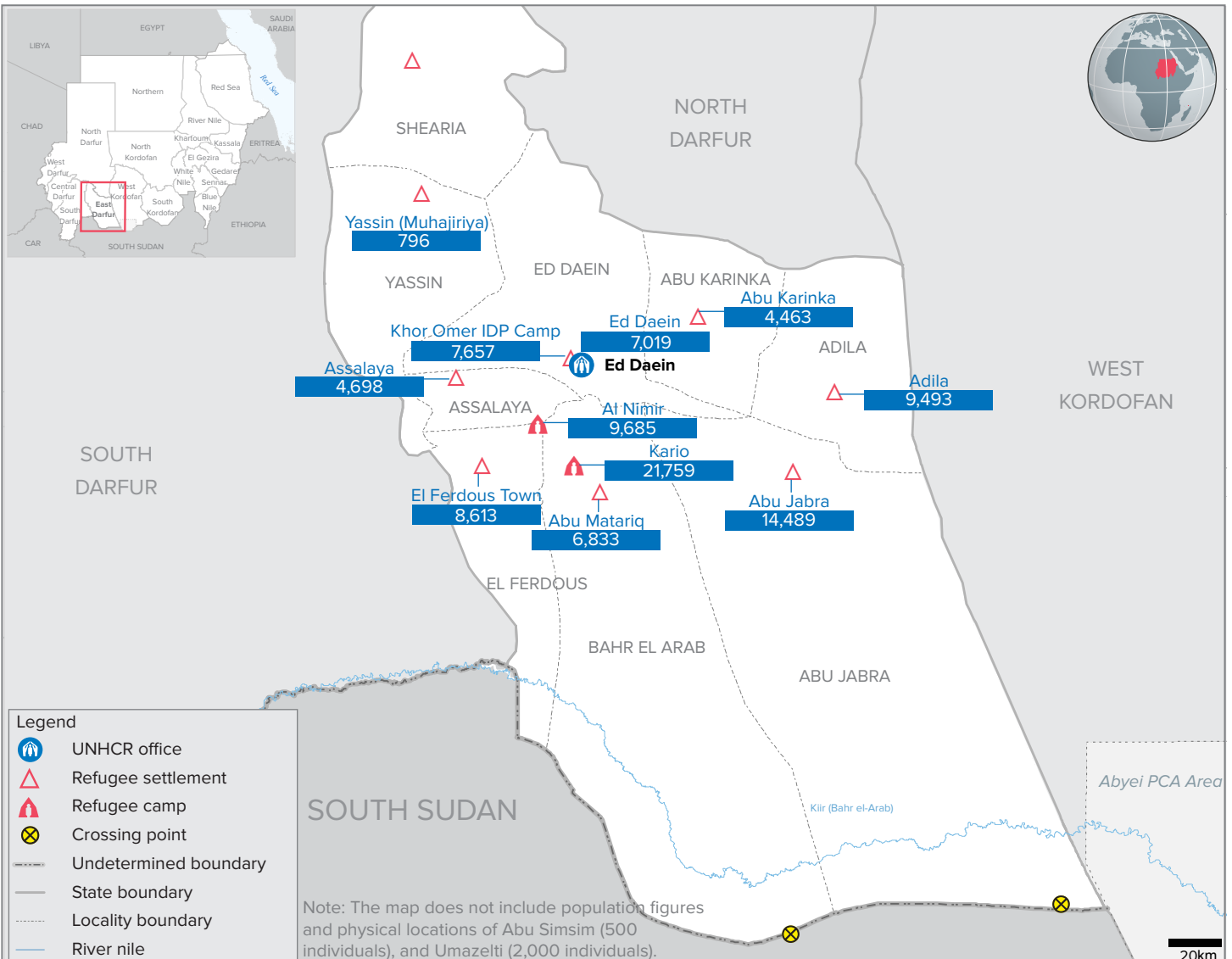

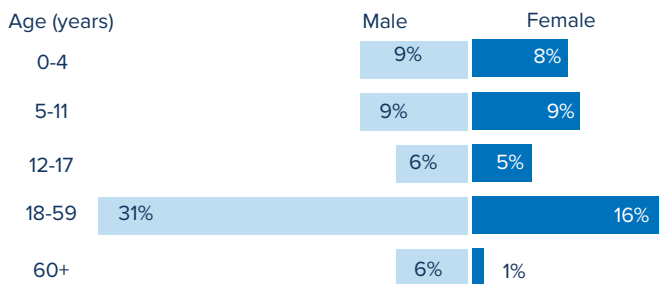

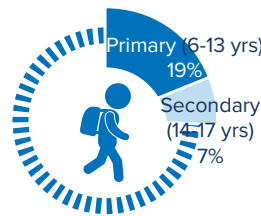

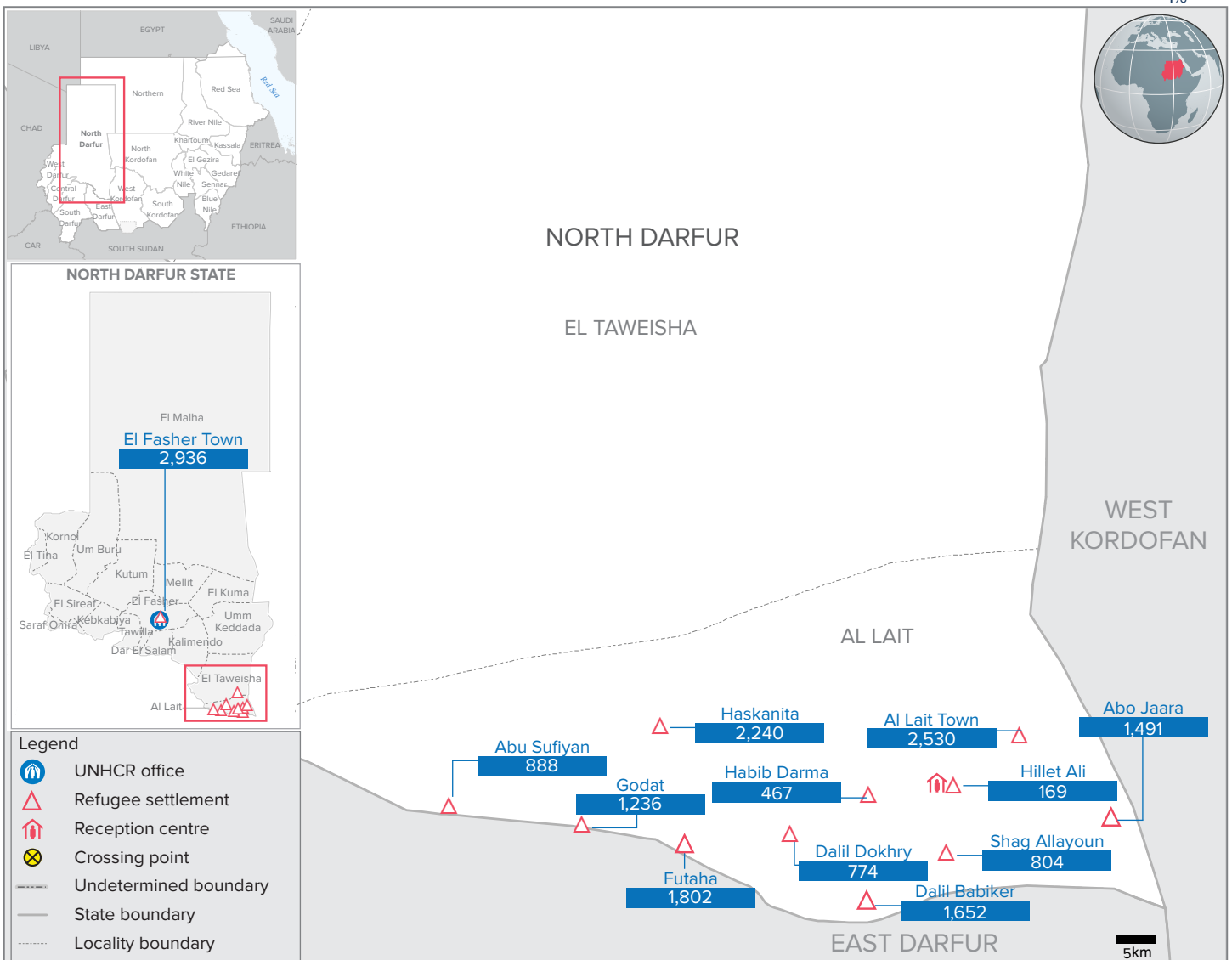

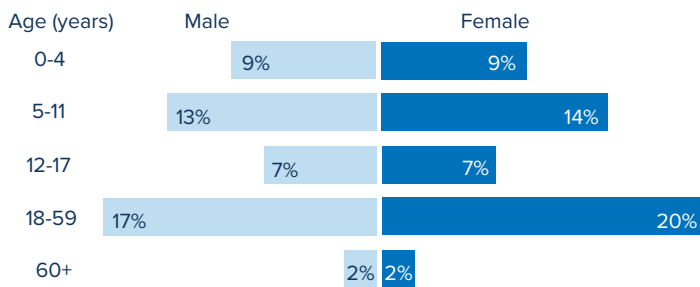

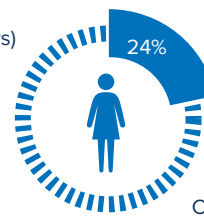

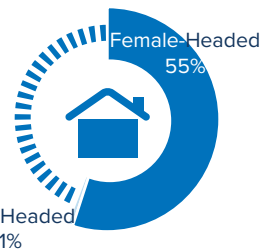

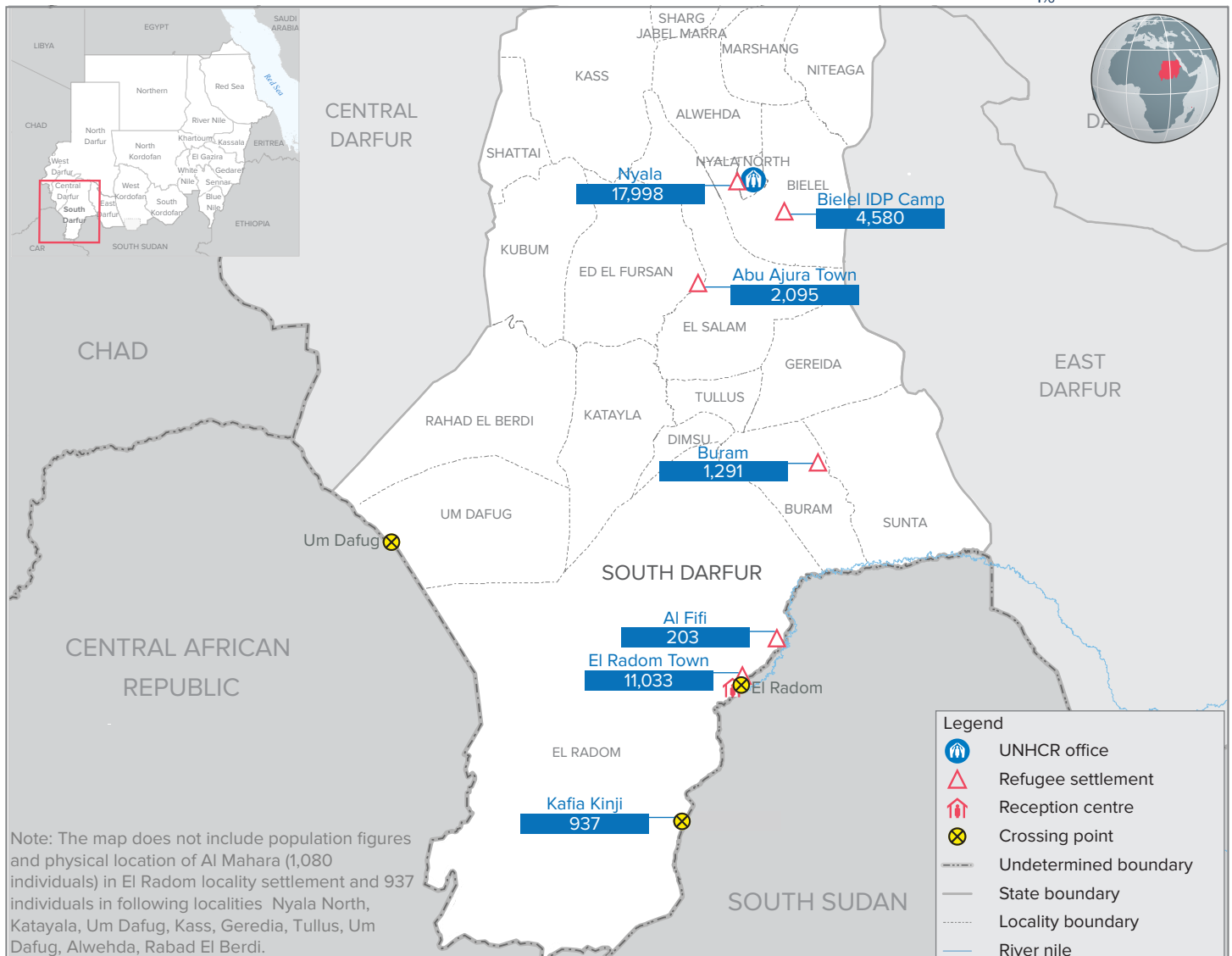

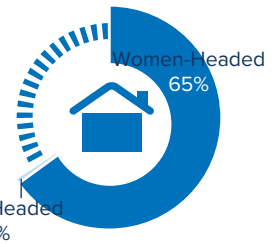

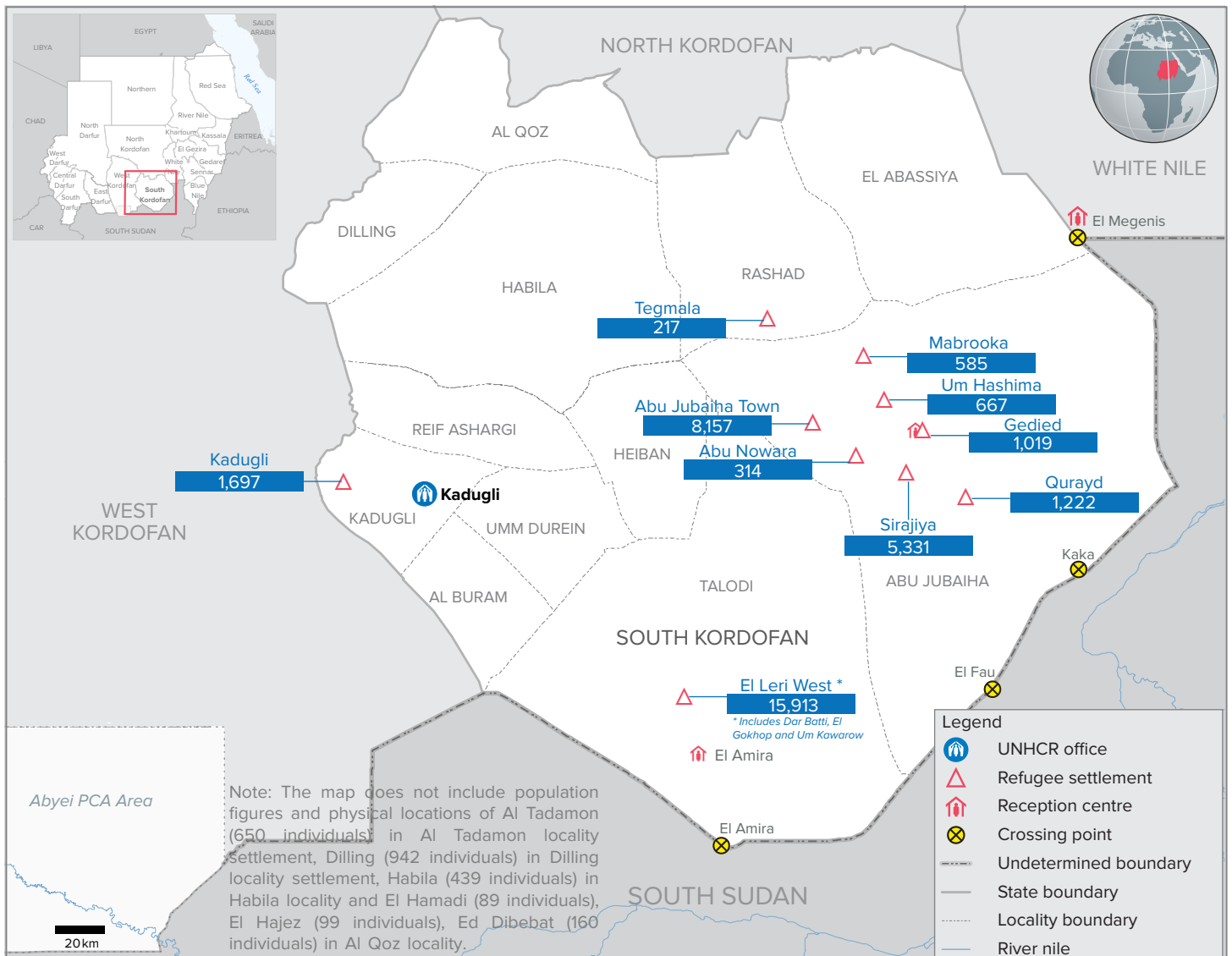

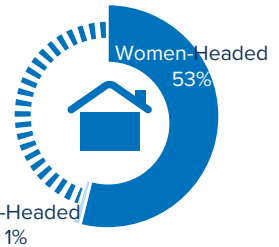

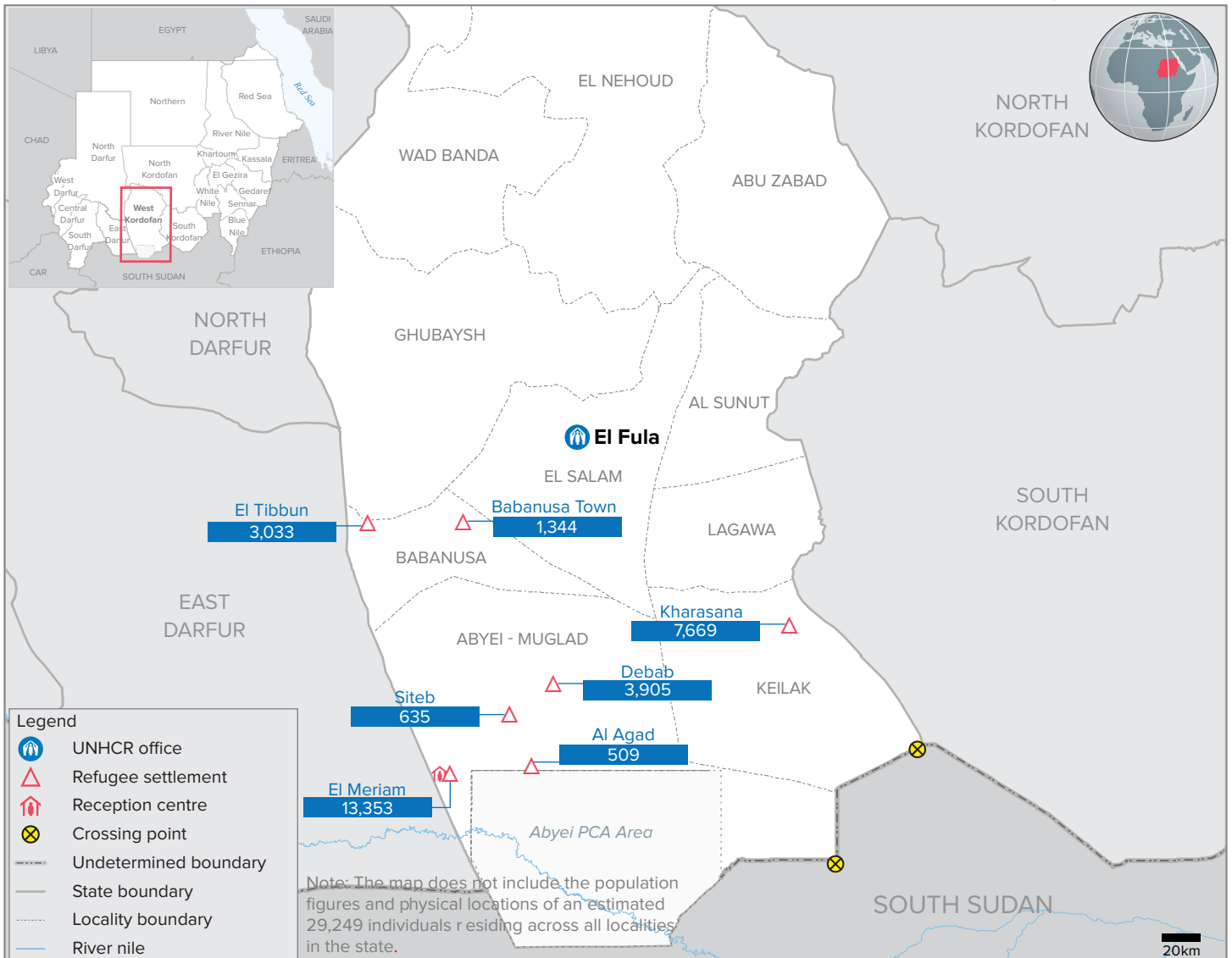

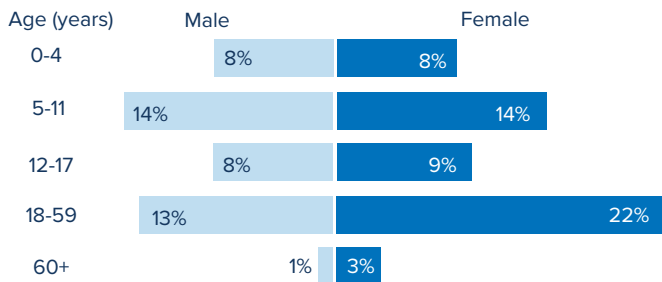
POPULATION DISTRIBUTION

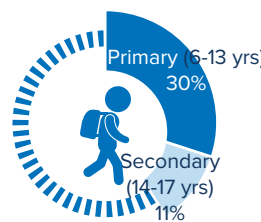
