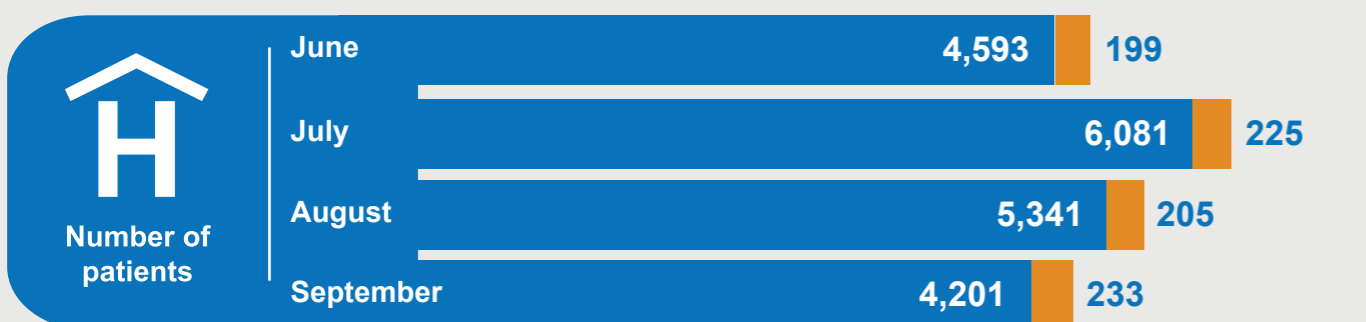
4,201 patients received at the clinic in the month of September.

45% of secondary and tertiary referrals were for obstetrics & gynaecology.

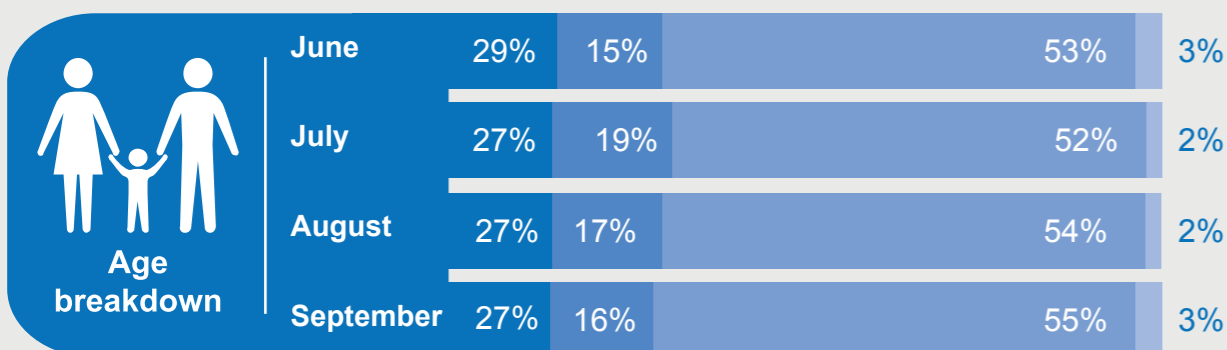

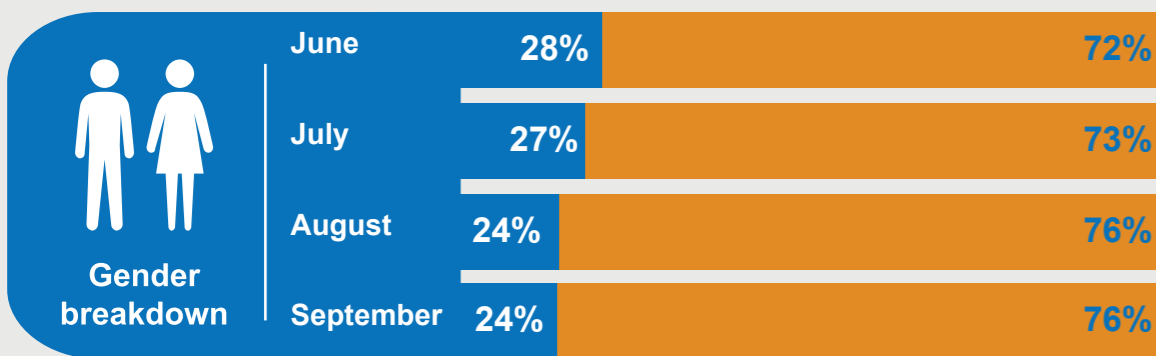


■ During the month ■ Daily average*

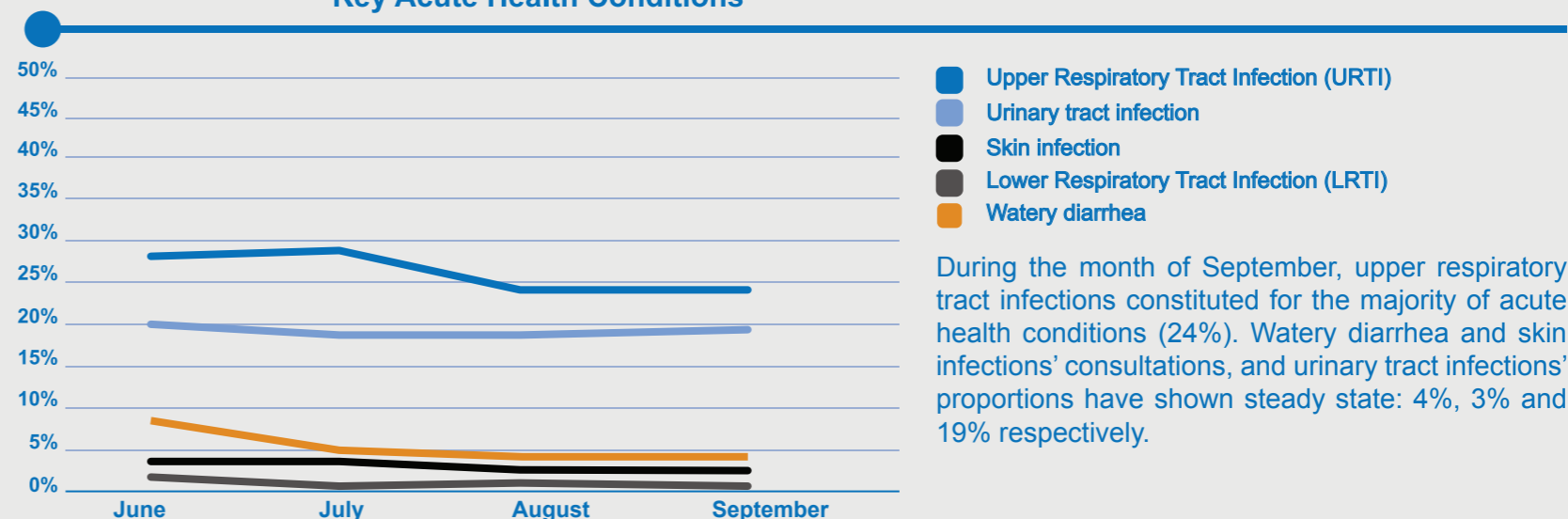


■ Below 5 ■ 5 to 18 ■ 18 to 59 ■ Above 60



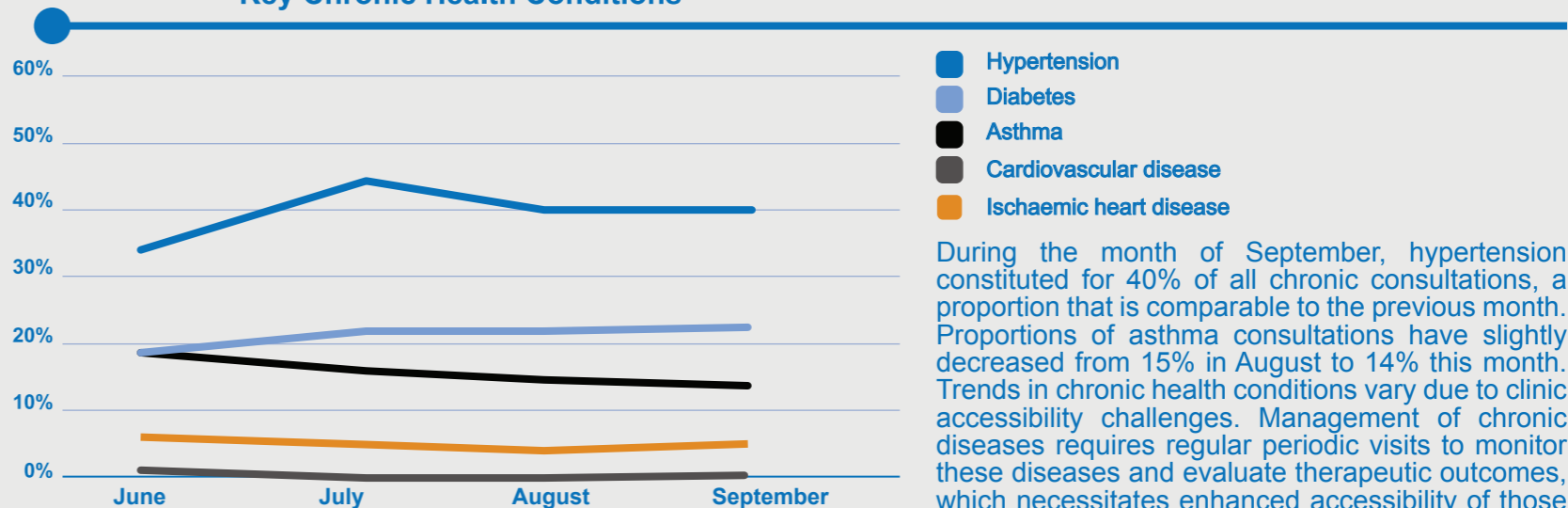

Key Acute Health Conditions



During the month of September, upper respiratory tract infections constituted for the majority of acute health conditions (24%). Watery diarrhea and skin infections' consultations, and urinary tract infections' proportions have shown steady state: 4%, 3% and 19% respectively.

Key Chronic Health Conditions



During the month of September, hypertension constituted for 40% of all chronic consultations, a proportion that is comparable to the previous month. Proportions of asthma consultations have slightly decreased from 15% in August to 14% this month. Trends in chronic health conditions vary due to clinic accessibility challenges. Management of chronic diseases requires regular periodic visits to monitor these diseases and evaluate therapeutic outcomes, which necessitates enhanced accessibility of those morbid cases to the health care facility.

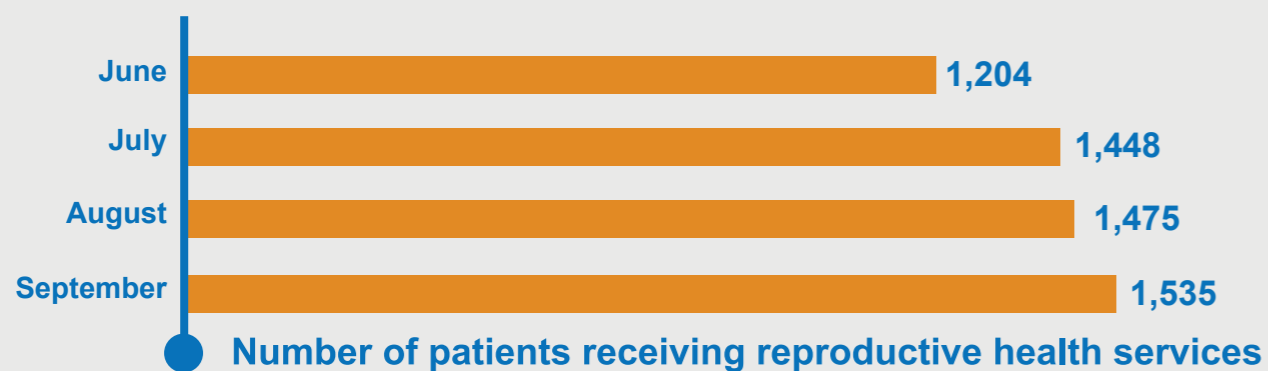


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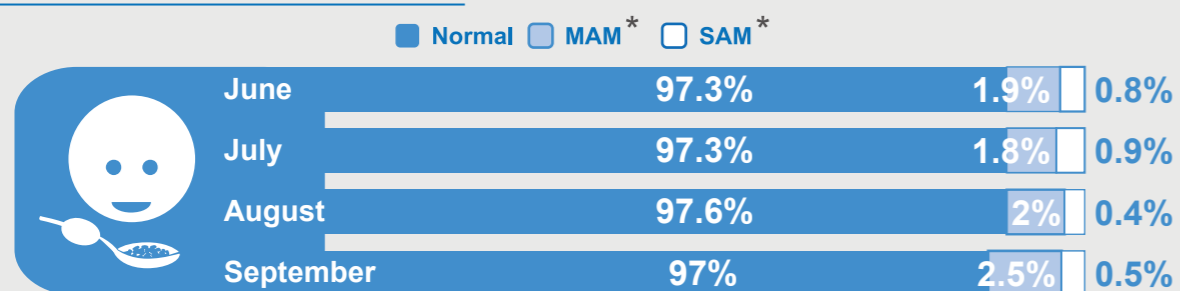

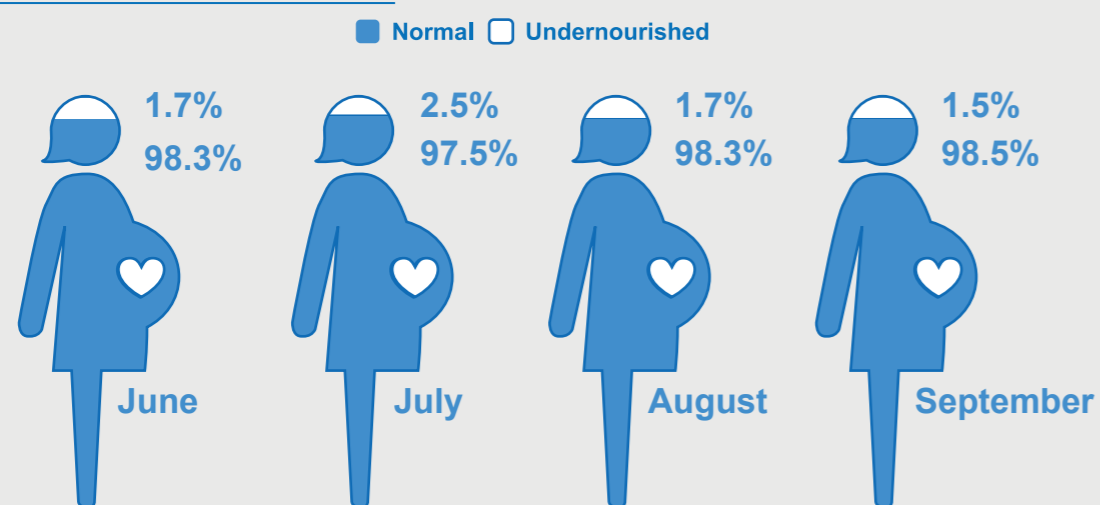
4 Nutrition status among:
