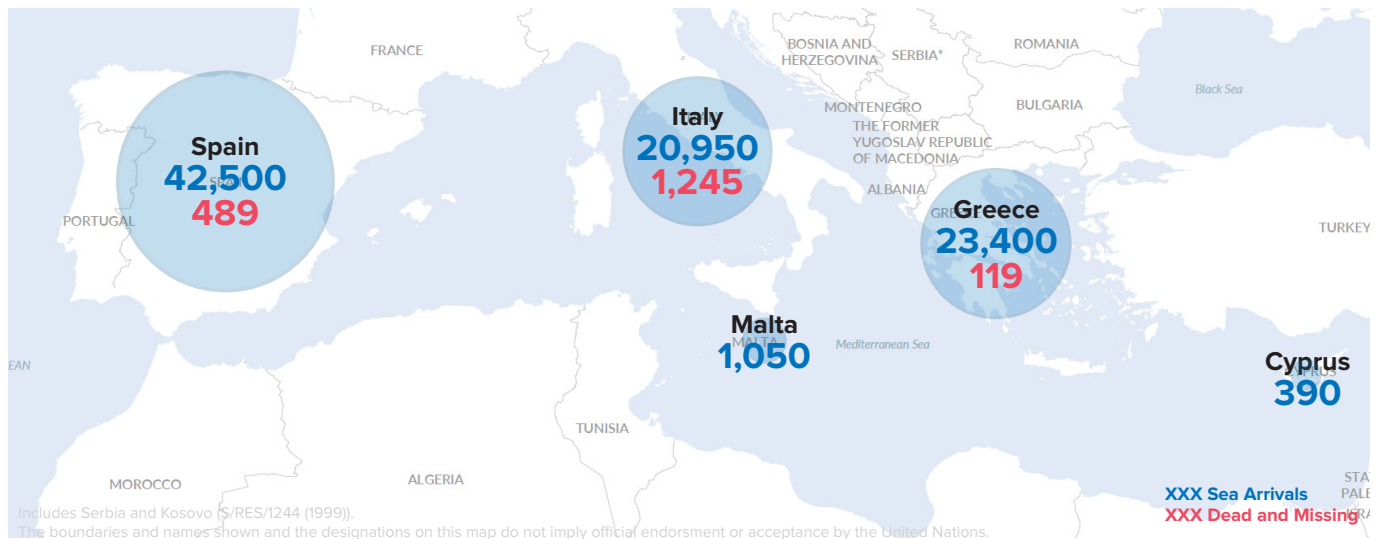

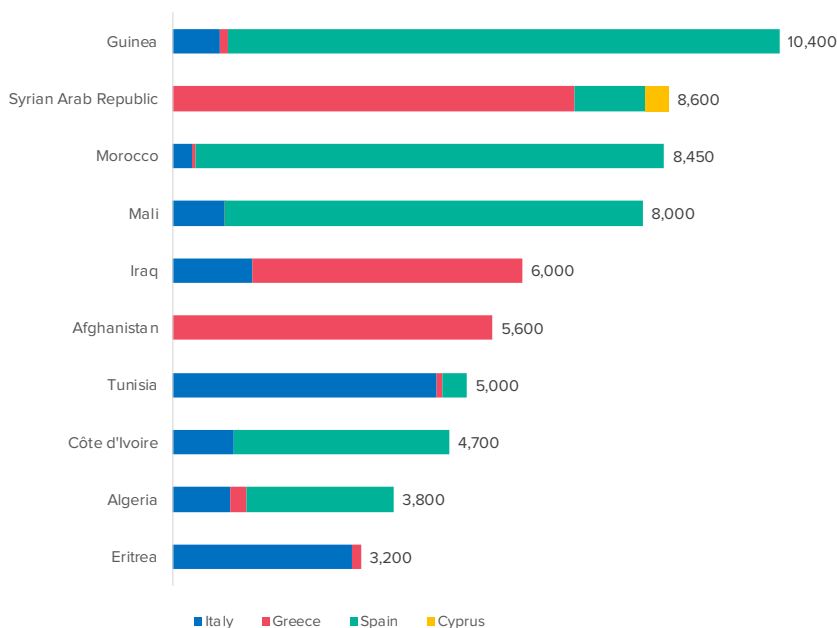

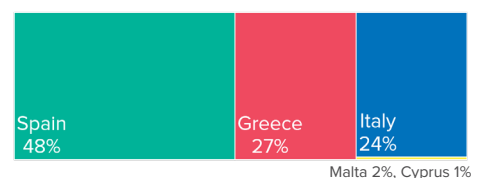

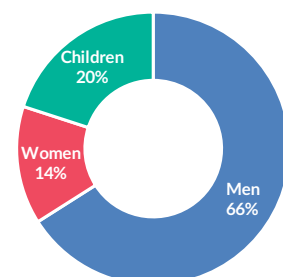
Most common nationalities of Mediterranean arrivals Q1 - Q3 2018¹

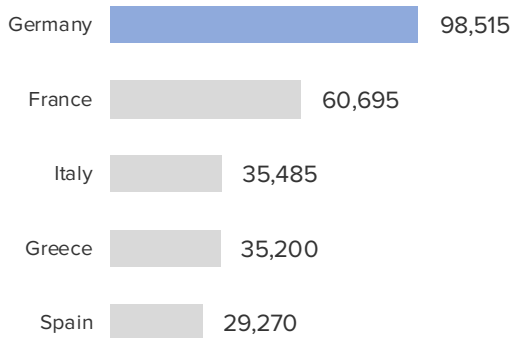
New Asylum Applications in EU+ countries in 2018

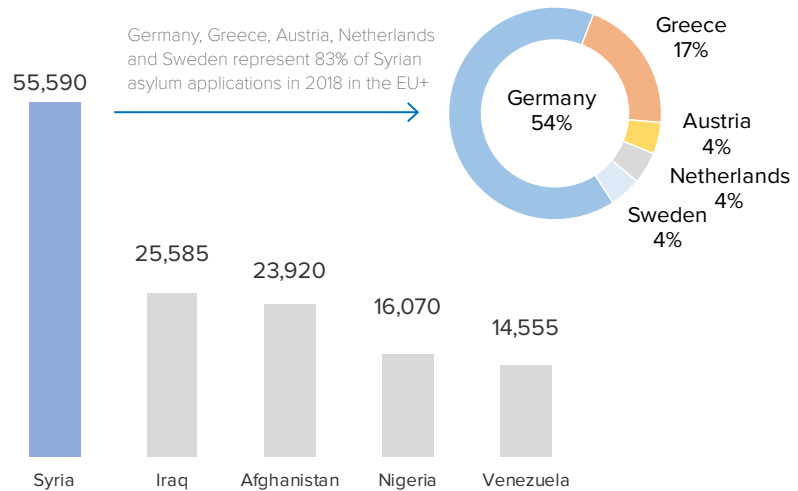

Most common countries of asylum in the EU+ in January-July 2018



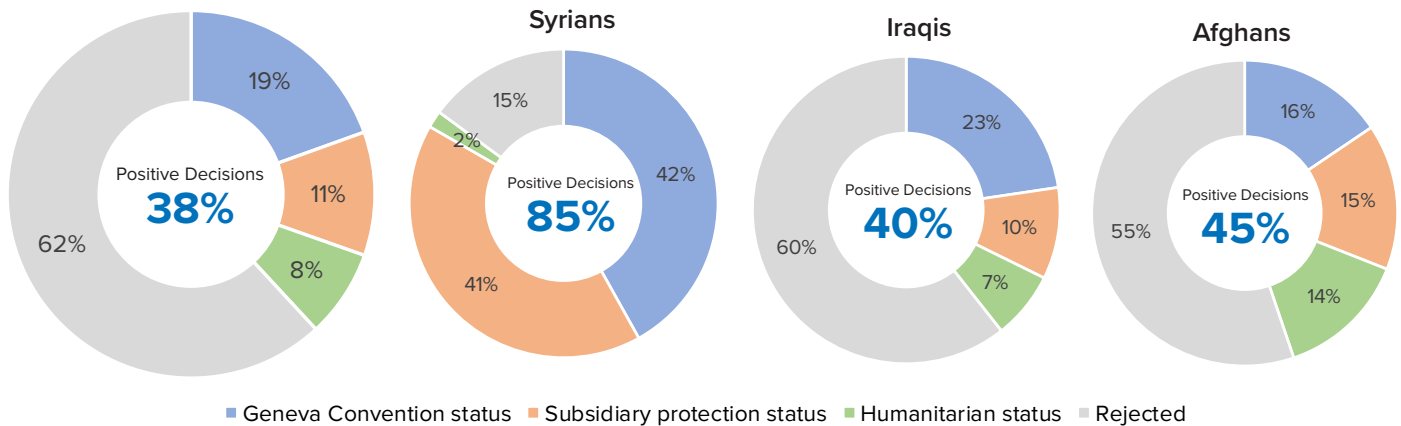

Top Nationalities of EU+ First Instance Decisions (Q1+Q2 2018)

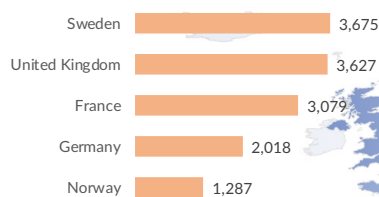

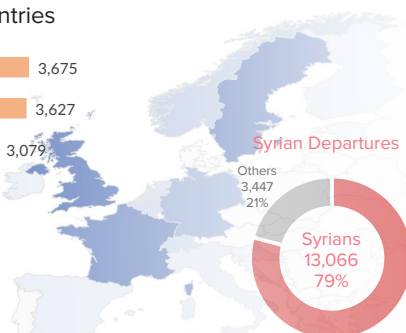
Most common receiving countries

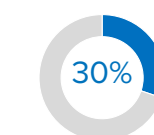

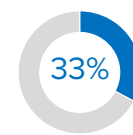
