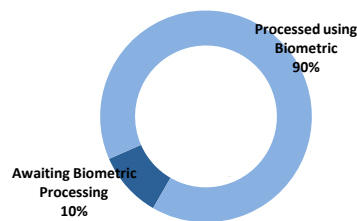

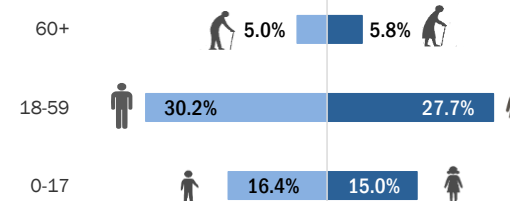

Age-Gender Breakdown

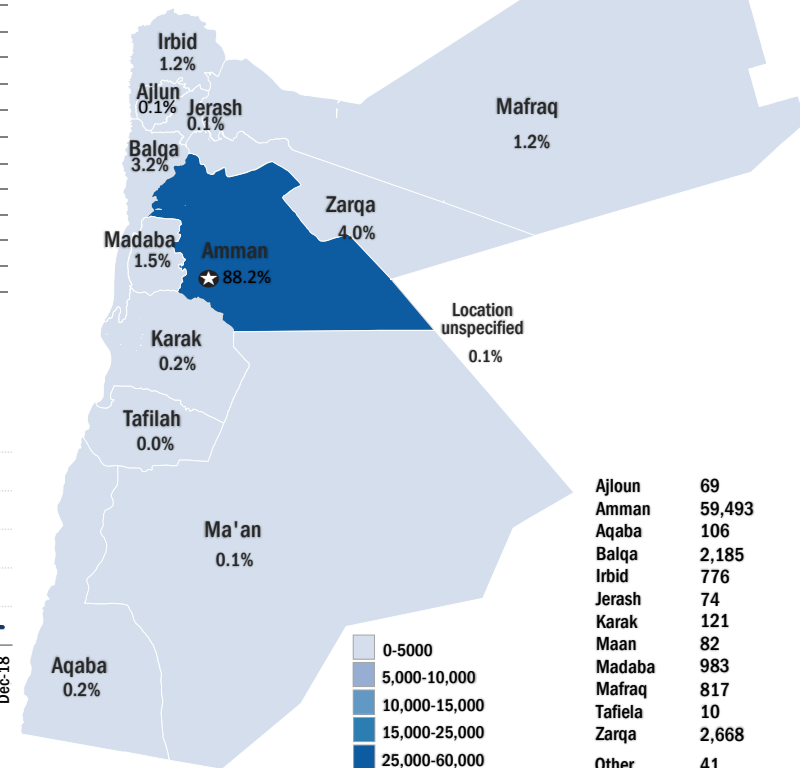
