¹Actual capacity is calculated as the subtraction of current places minus 13.5% which is this week's estimated average natural loss for mainland and 7.5% for islands. Natural loss is the number of places that cannot currently be used because of damages/repairs, protection issues, family size, etc. The formula applies to all type of accommodation. Actual capacity is a close estimate of available places to be used as reference.

In some cases, current population may exceeds the actual capacity due to the estimation of the natural loss.

²Occupancy rate is calculated as the percentage of current population over actual capacity.

The actual available capacity is estimated to be at 350 places (mainland: 254 / islands: 96).

As of today 212 places have been reserved for planned transfers (mainland: 149 / islands: 63).

Considering an average natural loss (10-15%) the estimated remaining available places are 114 (mainland: 85 / islands: 29)
