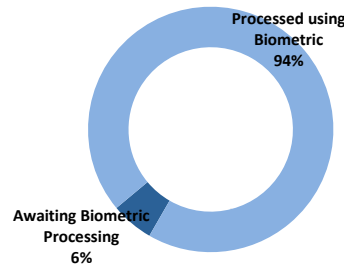

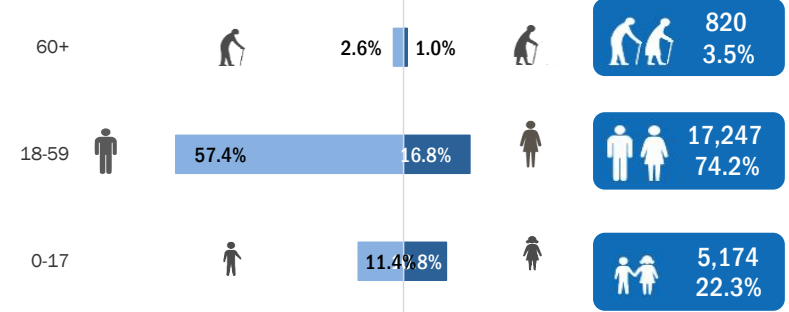

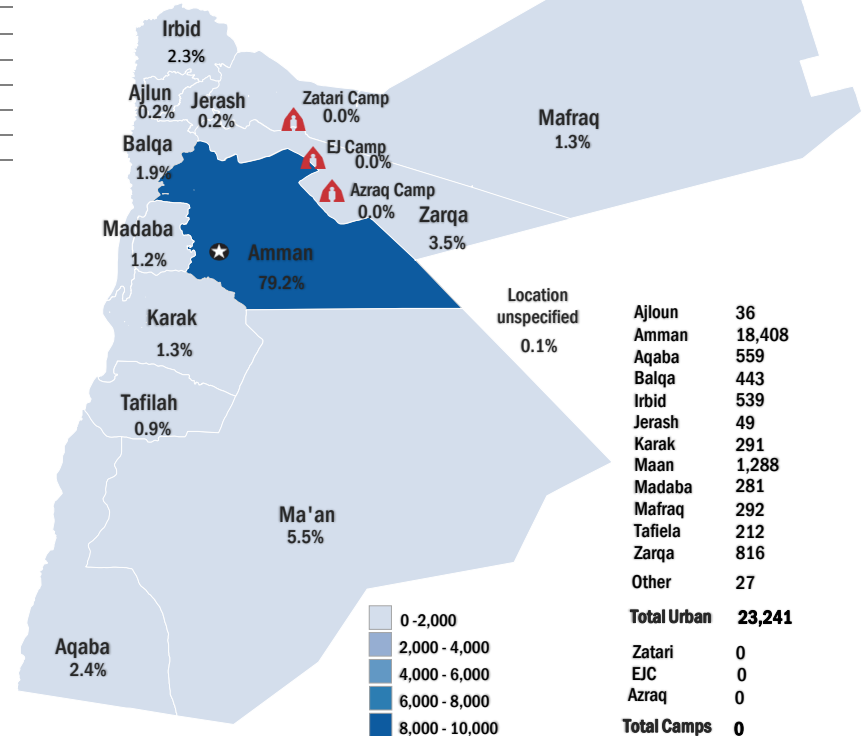

**Age-Gender Breakdown**



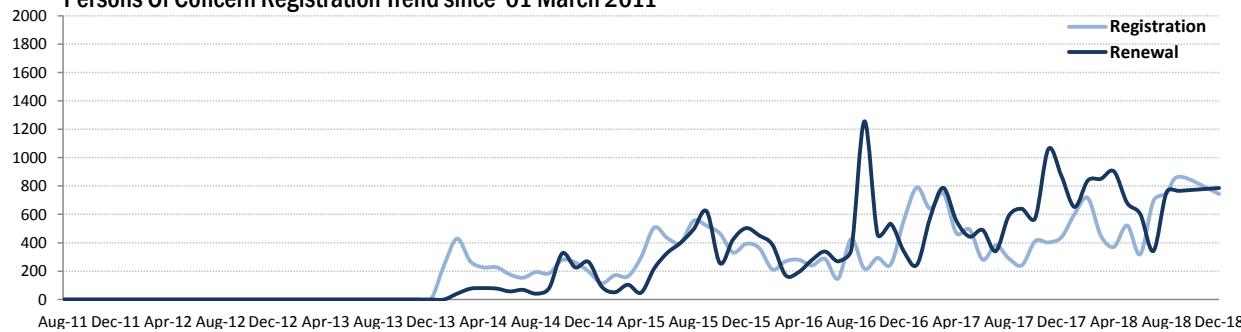
