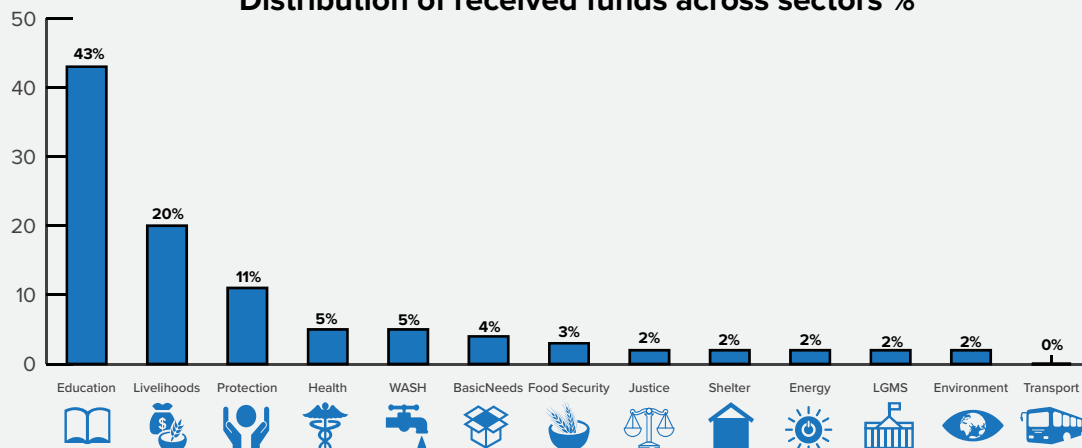

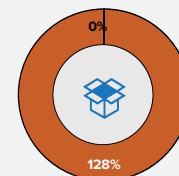
Distribution of received funds across sectors %



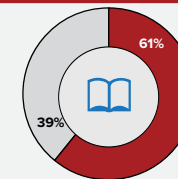
