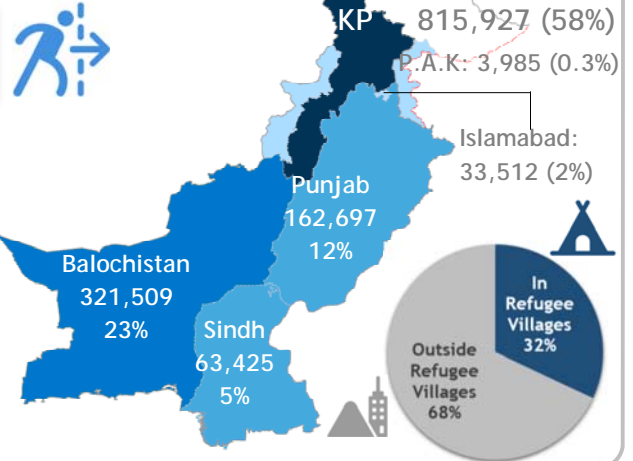

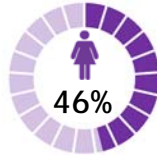

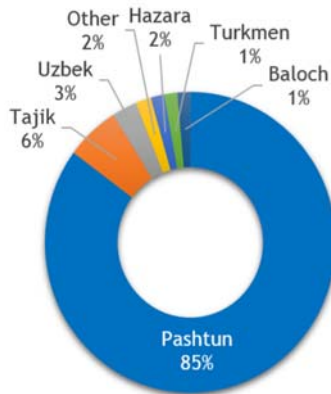

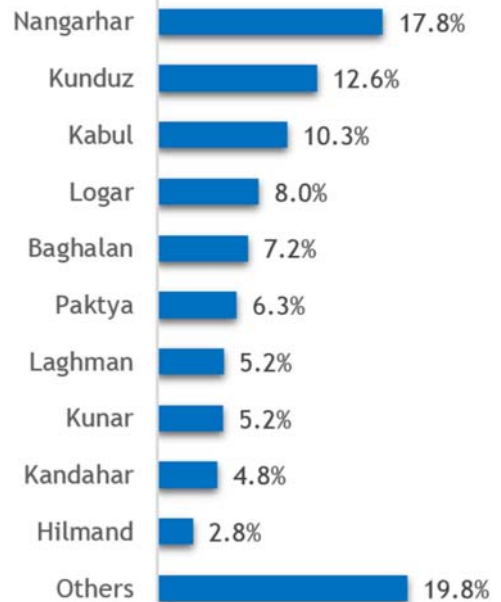

Voluntary repatriation comparison by months



14,017 individuals facilitated for Voluntary Repatriation between 1 March to 30 Nov 2018 from Pakistan, out of 14,017 the total number of individuals entitled for cash assistance is 13,582. Remaining 435 received UNHCR's cash assistance in the past. Voluntary repatriation for the reported year has been suspended from 1 December till 28 February 2019 due to winter break.

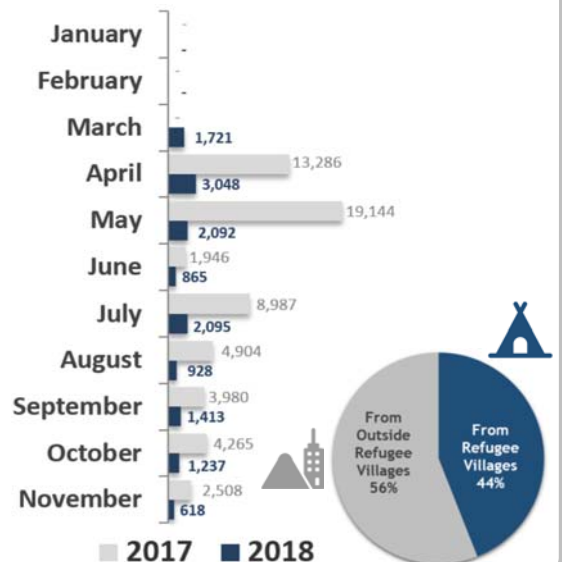
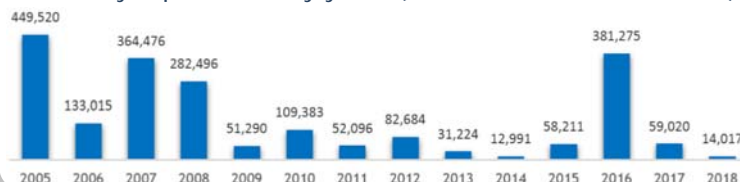
Women and Children of overall repatriation

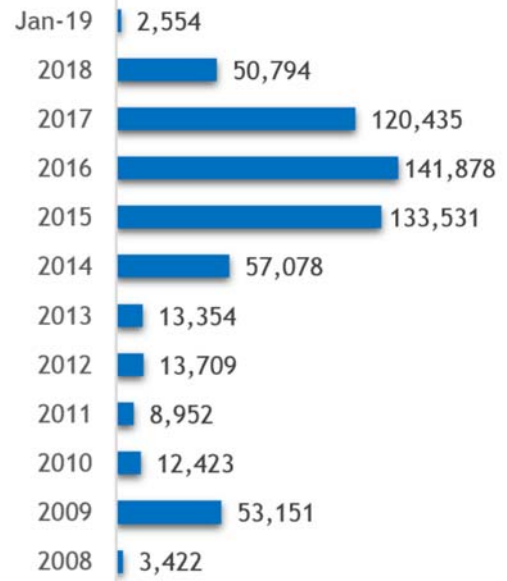

In 2019, UNHCR prioritised funds for birth registration and the issuance of birth certificates to 70,000 children. The target for the issuance of individual PoR cards is 170,000 children who have reached five years of age and are eligible to receive their individual cards from the PCM centres.

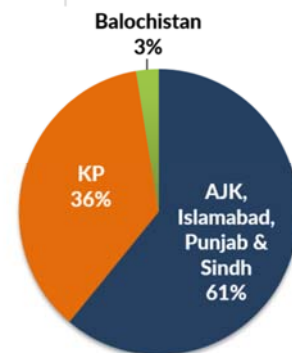
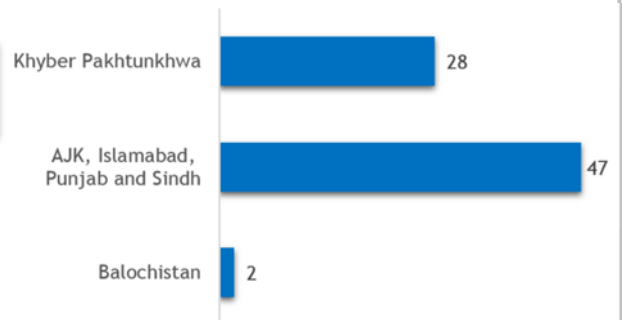

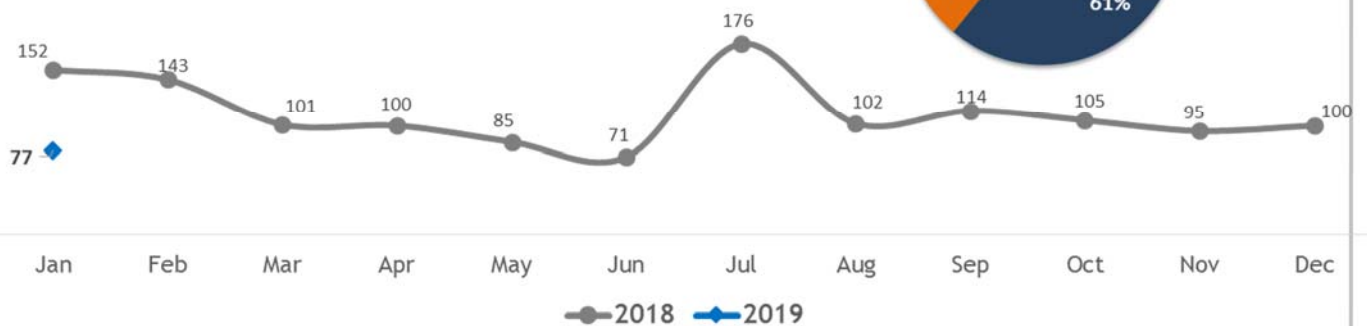
