<sup>1</sup>Actual capacity is calculated as the subtraction of current places minus 14.5% which is this week's estimated average natural loss for mainland and 4.5% for islands. Natural loss is the number of places that cannot currently be used because of damages/repairs, protection issues, family size, etc. The formula applies to all type of accommodation. Actual capacity is a close estimate of available places to be used as reference.

In some cases, current population may exceeds the actual capacity due to the estimation of the natural loss.

<sup>2</sup>Occupancy rate is calculated as the percentage of current population over actual capacity.

The actual available capacity is estimated to be at 552 places (mainland: 391 / islands: 161).

As of today 347 places have been reserved for planned transfers (mainland: 281 / islands: 66).

Considering an average natural loss (10-15%) the remaining available places are 162 (mainland: 74 / islands: 88)
