





POPULATION BY STATE






POPULATION DISTRIBUTION




AGE-GENDER BREAKDOWN<sup>3</sup>




SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS)<sup>3</sup>




REPRODUCTIVE-AGED WOMEN/GIRLS (13-49 YRS)<sup>3</sup>




HOUSEHOLD DISTRIBUTION<sup>3</sup>




ARRIVALS BY STATE
