### Analysis of Humanitarian Services available in Camp

- i. WASH, Education and Protection has highest number of presence in the camps.
- ii. Protection, GBV, CP, Education and WASH partners are present in all governorates hosting camps.
- iii. Protection, GBV, CP, Education and WASH has highest number of partners.
- iv. Only Duhok governorate hosting camps has all cluster partners presence.
- v. Local Authorities and line ministry has presence in almost all the camps.
- vi. All 72 camps were reached out for FSMT.
- vii. 30 camps have more than 70% partners presence while 11 camps have less than 50% partners presence.

- i. Social Cohesion, Livelihood and CWC has the lowest number of presence in the camps. Only 11 camps have CWC services available in the camp.
- ii. There is no single camp that has all the services available.
- iii. Secondary Health Care center is available only in 22 camps compared to 59 Primary Health Center.
- iv. There are governorates hosting camps without Shelter, Water, Sanitation, NFI, PHC, SHC, Food, Nutrition, Livelihood, Social Cohesion and CWC partners.
- v. 6 governorates hosting camps doesn't have Secondary Health Care facilities inside camps.
- vi. Nutrition, Food, Social Cohesion, Livelihood and CWC has lowest number of partners.
- vii. 13 camps still doesn't have Primary Health Center.

*N.B. Partners presence or service available doesn't necessarily mean that they are physically present in the sites but maybe providing support on need basis or through other nearby sites*
