







SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS)⁴









SCHOOL- AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS) ⁴




SCHOOL- AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS)⁴




REPRODUCTIVE- AGED WOMEN/GIRLS (13-49 YRS)⁴




POPULATION DISTRIBUTION




SCHOOL- AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS) ⁴






AGE-GENDER BREAKDOWN⁴






REPRODUCTIVE-AGED WOMEN/GIRLS (13-49 YRS)⁴
