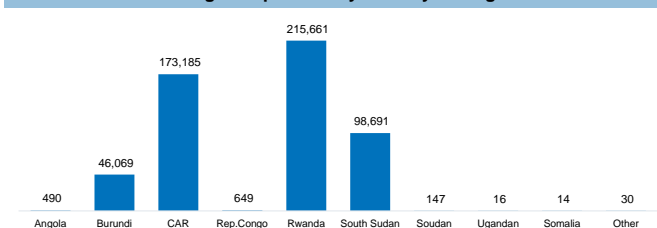

As of October 31, 2019, the number of Central African refugees in the DRC has slightly increased from 173,141 to 173,185. The increase is due to the regularization of cases who was transferred in the Inke camps in North Ubangi province
(***)The figure of 215,661 Rwandan refugees is the result of the registration done by the DRC Government in 2013-2014. During the Biometric verification exercise of Rwandan Refugees jointly conducted by CNR and UNHCR in 2015-2016 and 2018, a total of 76,091 individuals were biometrically enrolled.
(***)The figure of 98,691 south Sudanese includes the new caseload 96,908 and 1,783 old caseload. Out of the new caseload, 27,306 are pre-registered.

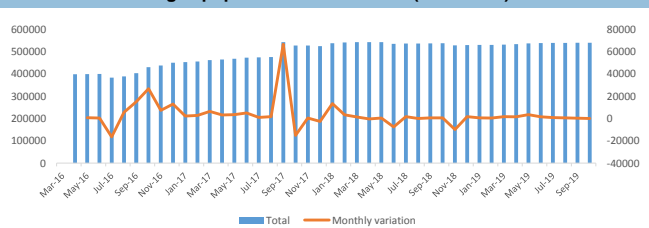
