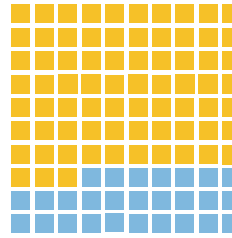
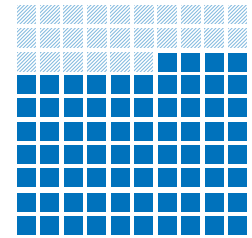

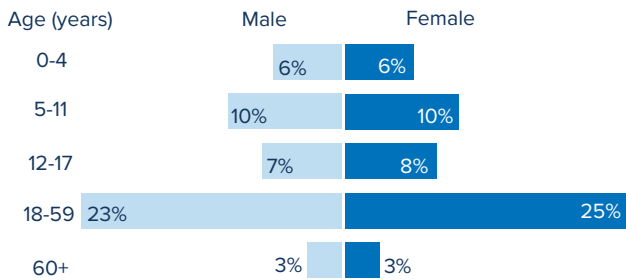
POPULATION DISTRIBUTION

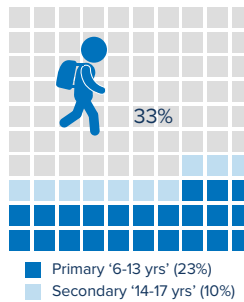

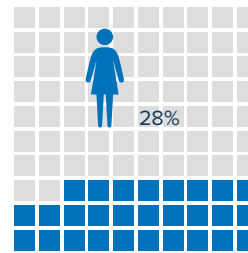

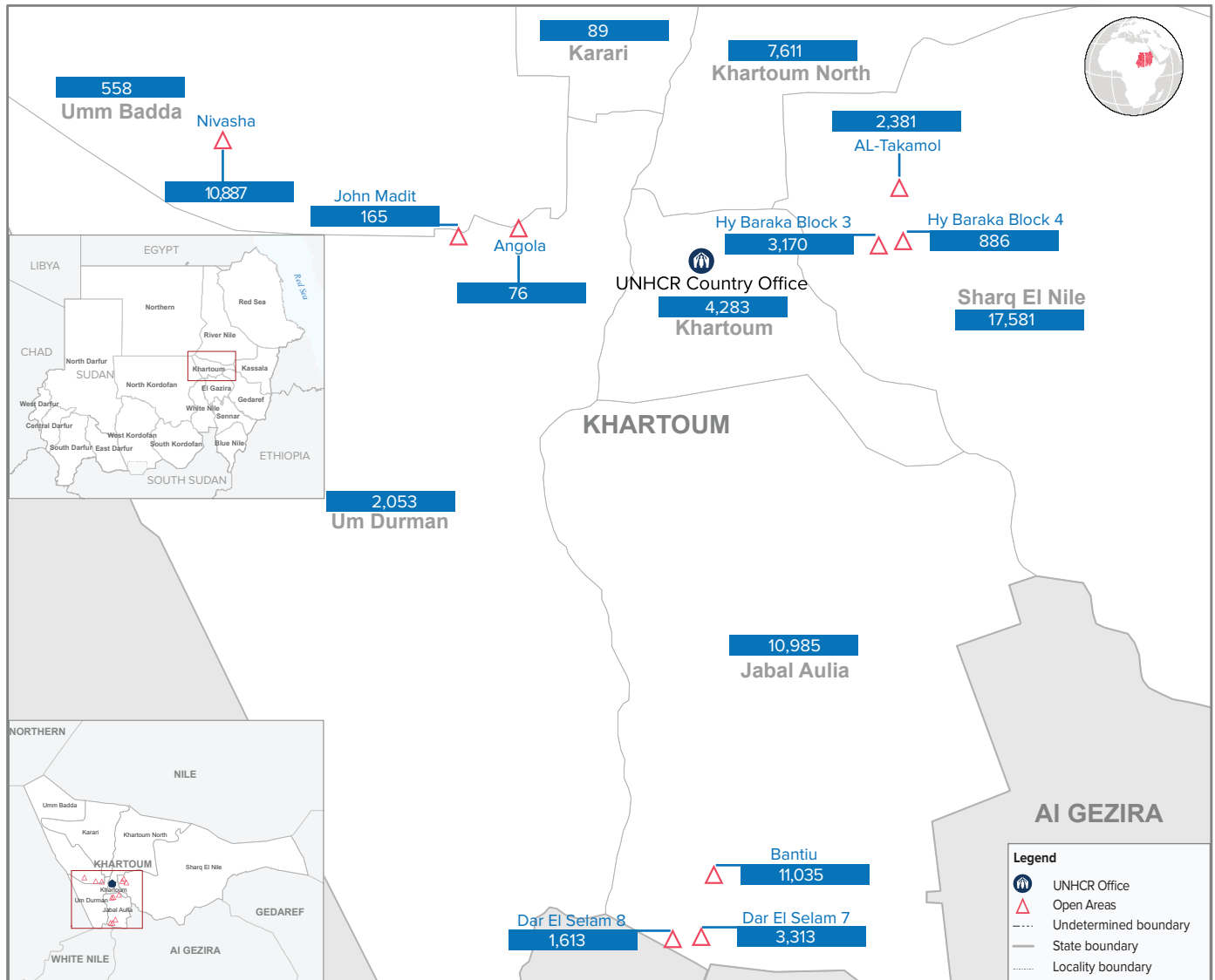
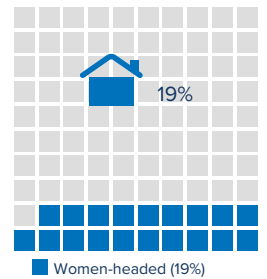
SCHOOL- AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS)⁴

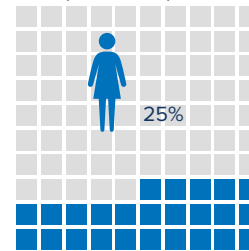

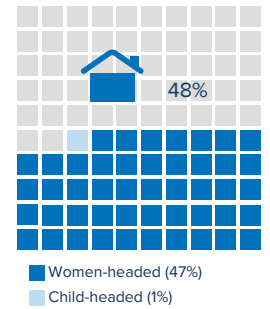
SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS) ****



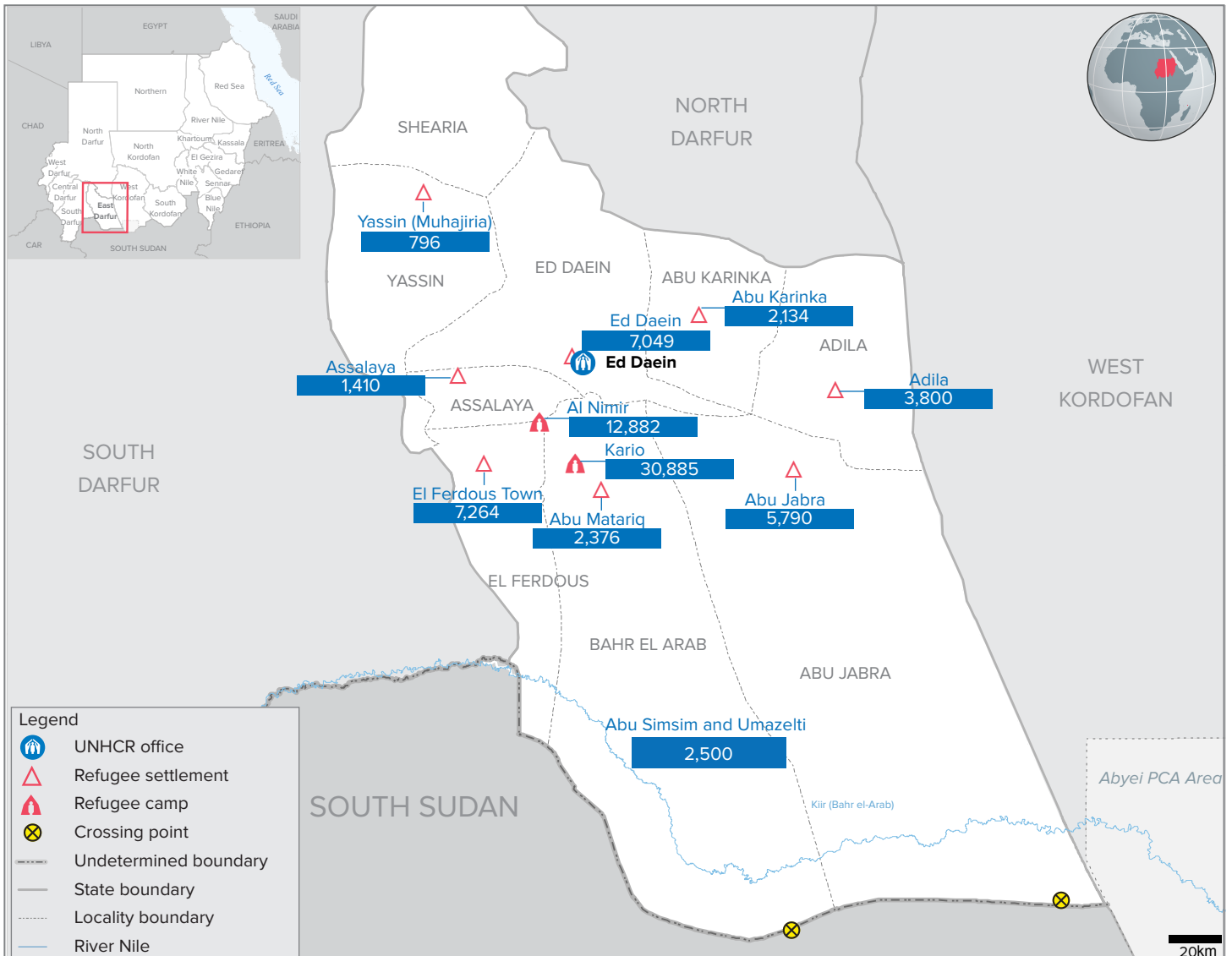

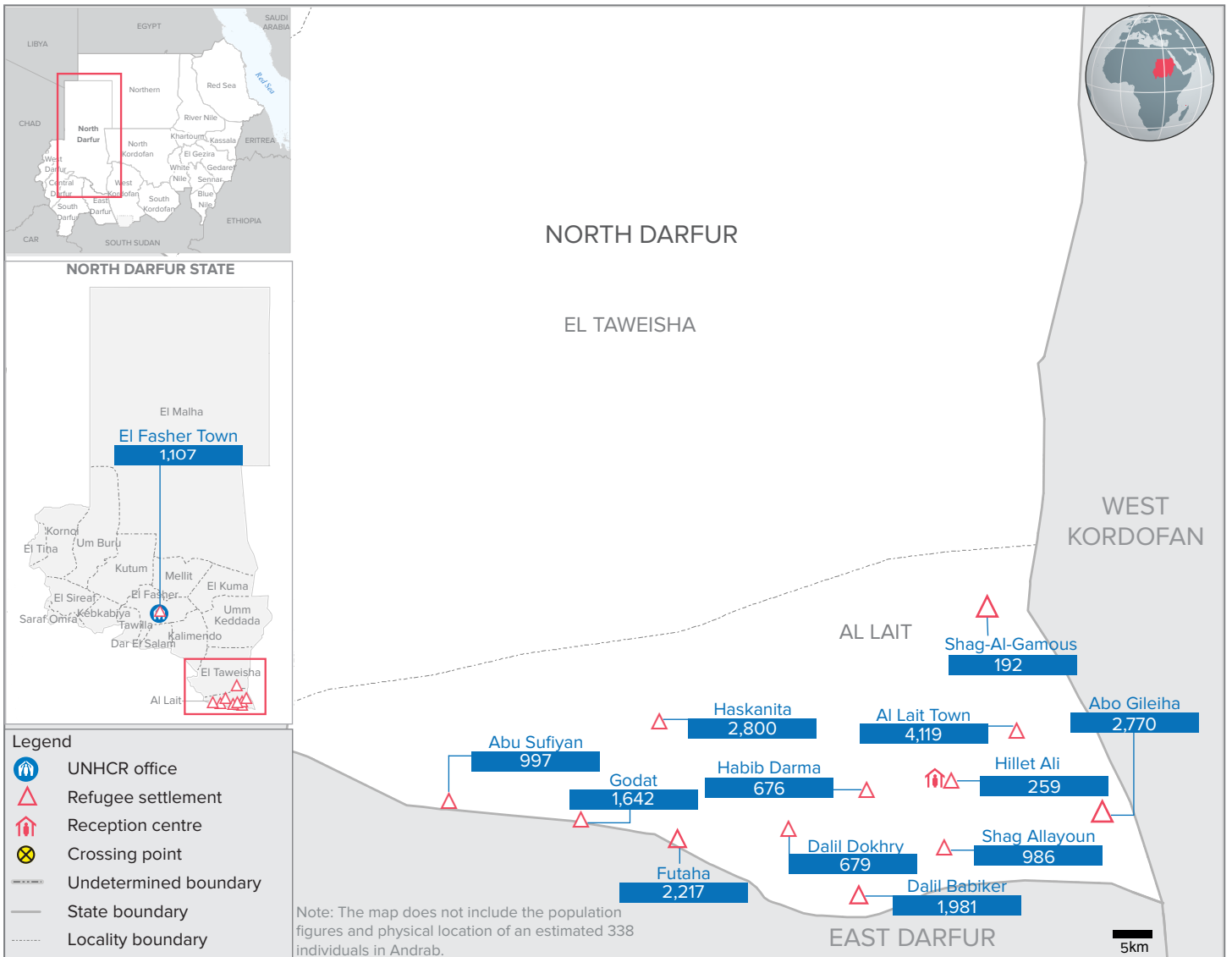

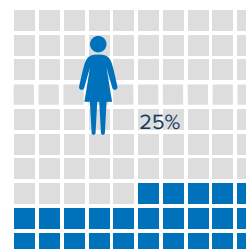

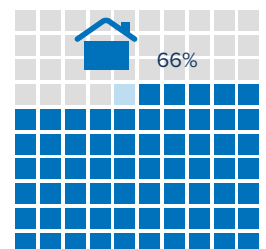

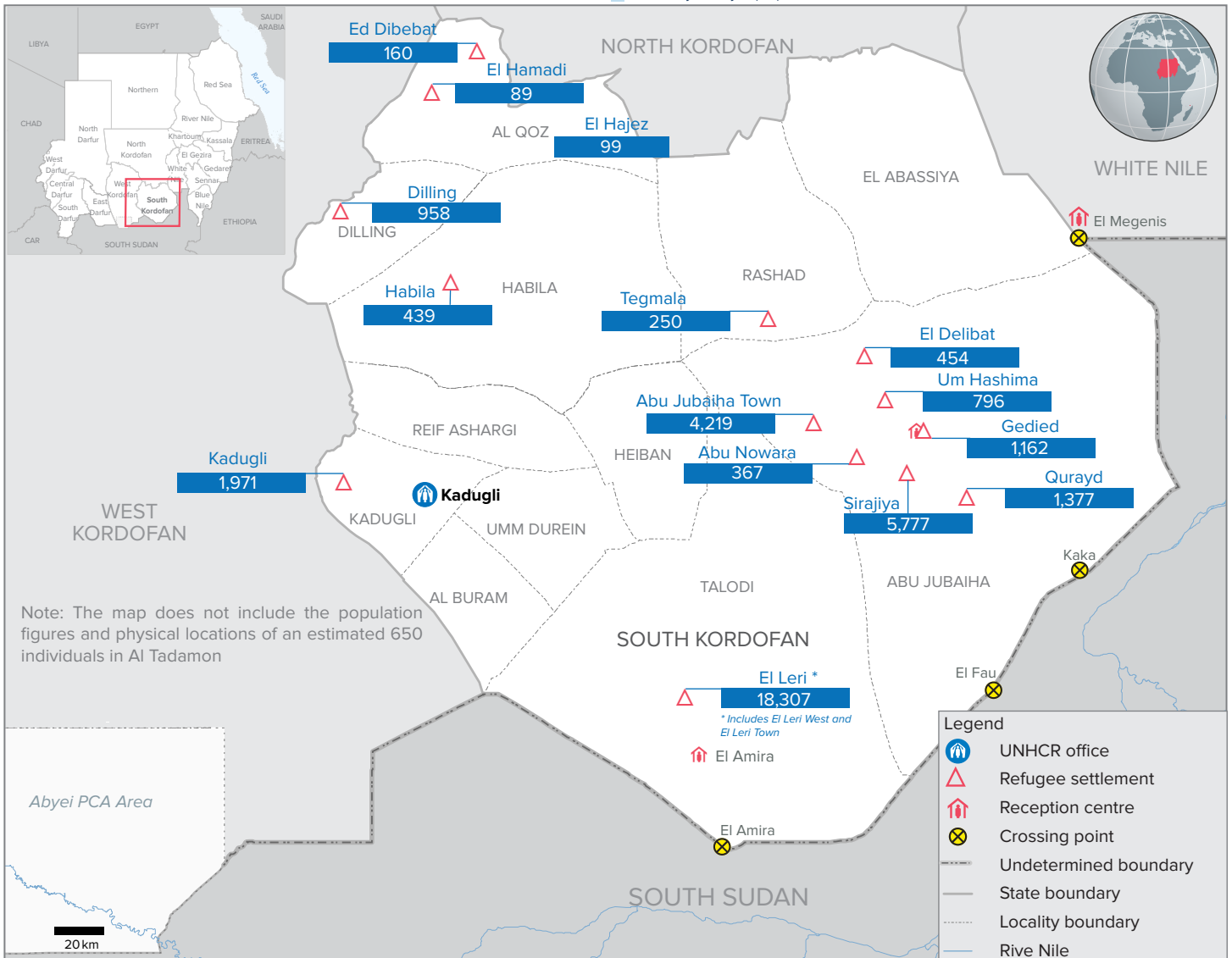

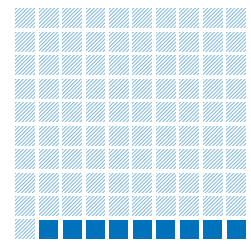

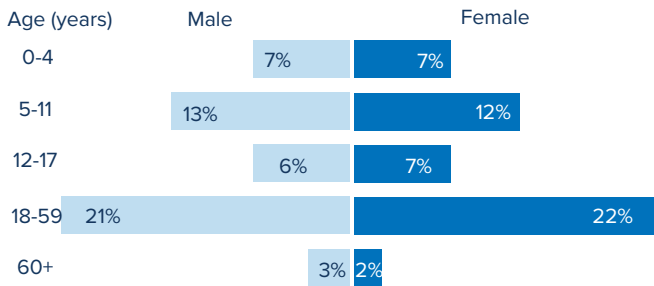

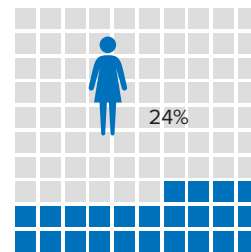
AGE-GENDER BREAKDOWN****



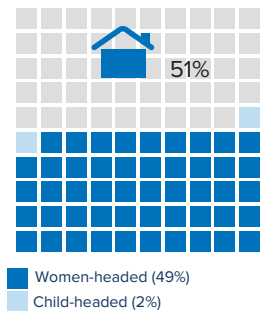

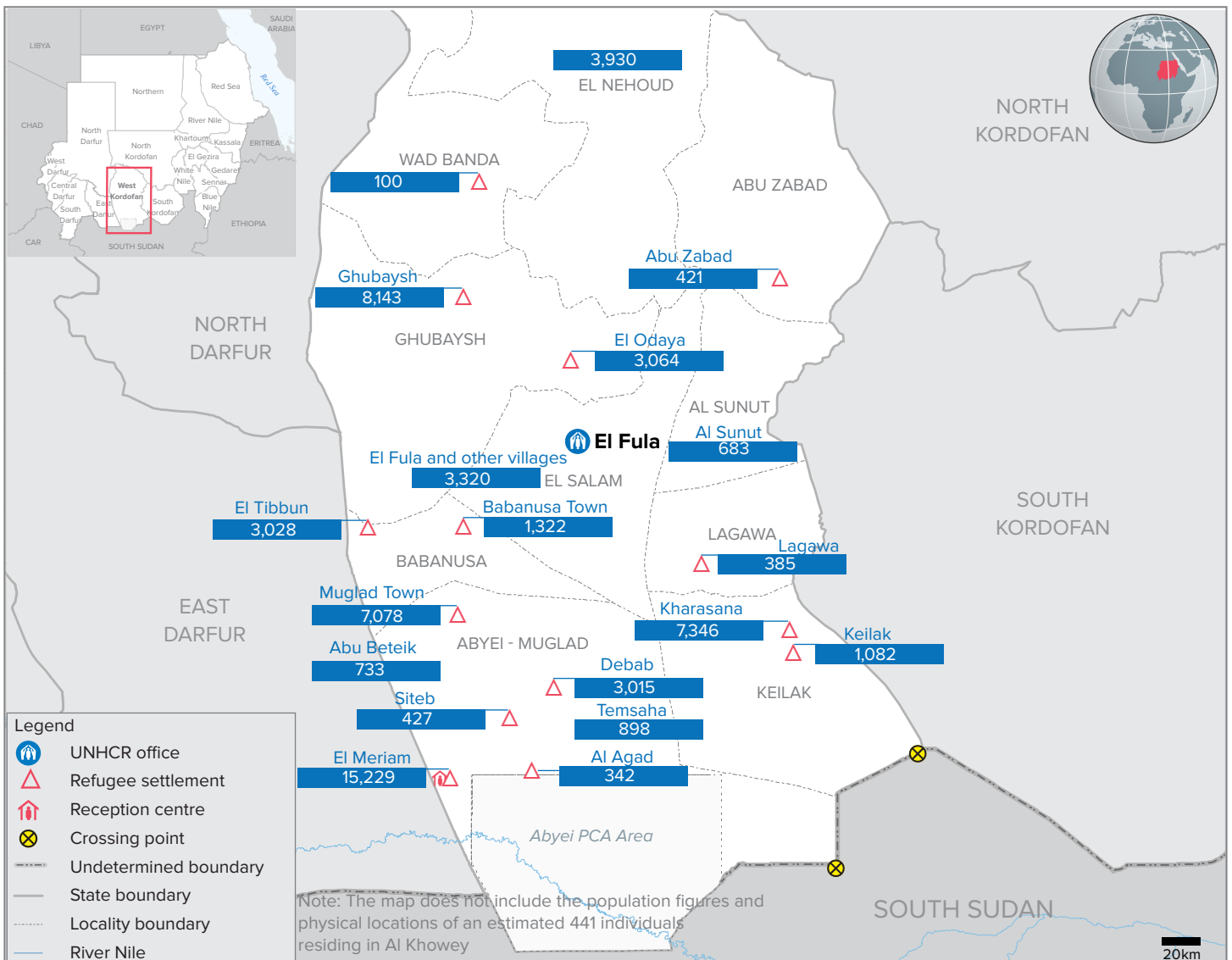

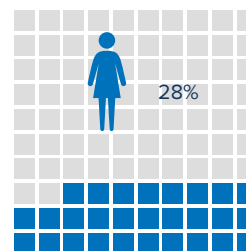
AGE-GENDER BREAKDOWN⁴



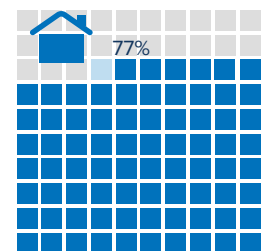

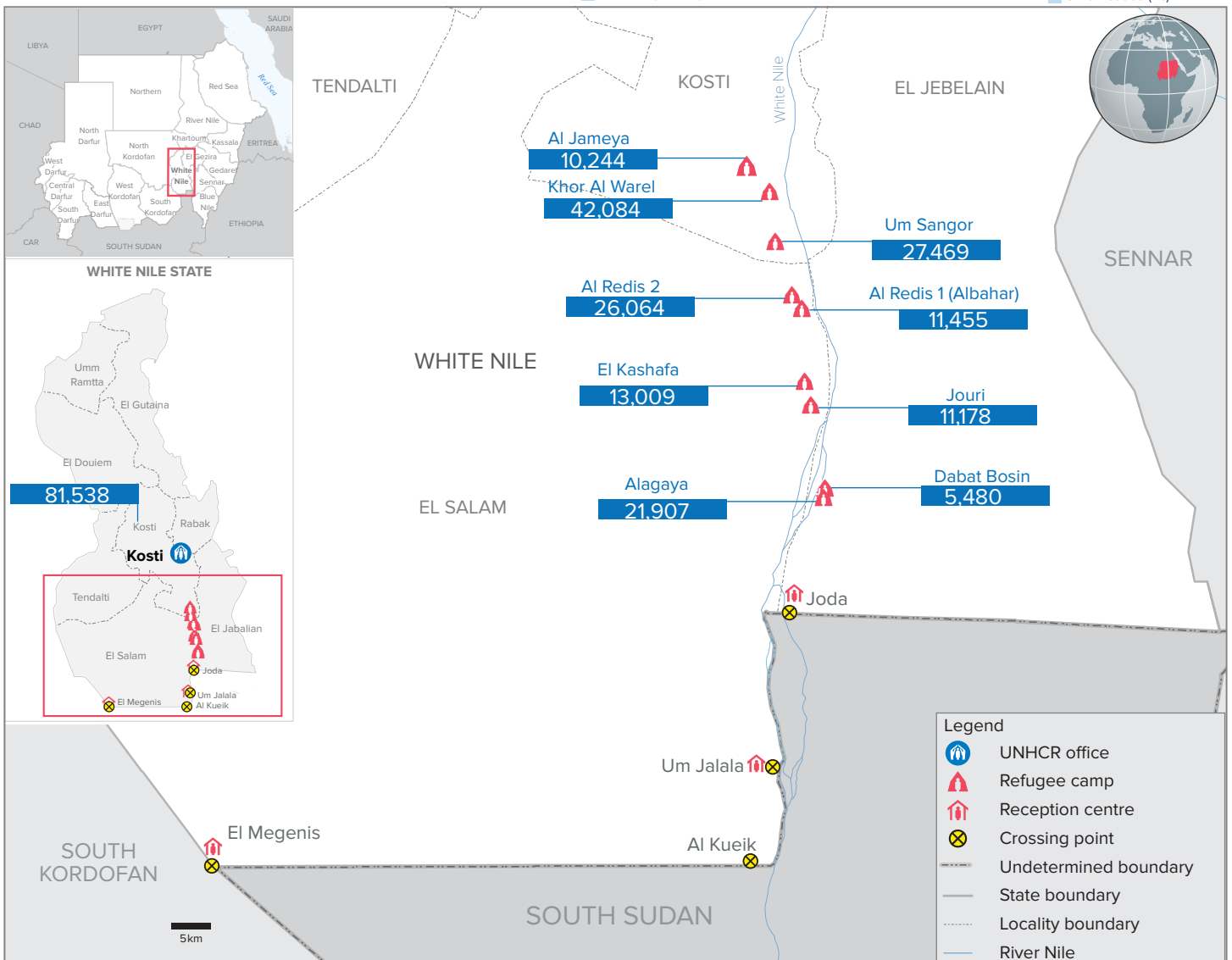
REPRODUCTIVE-AGED WOMEN/GIRLS (13-49 YRS)⁴
